





AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS:

Won National level 2nd prize for the best photographer of the year in a photo competition conducted by Press Institute of India and ICRC (International Committee of the Red Cross) on frontline workers during the time of crisis.

Programme Summary:

The School of Media Studies organized the second edition of Danish Siddiqui Memorial Lecture 'Looking Beyond the Lens 2.0' on the 17th July, 2023. The first edition of the same was organized in the year 2021 soon after the passing away of the photographer.

Danish Siddiqui was a two-time Pulitzer Prize-winning photojournalist who headed the Reuters multimedia team in India as its Chief Photographer. As a photojournalist, Danish covered several important stories in Asia, the Middle East, and Europe. His works included covering the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq, the COVID-19 pandemic in India, Indian citizenship law protests, Sri Lanka Easter bombing victims, Rohingya refugees crisis, Hong Kong protests, Nepal earthquakes, Mass Games in North Korea, and living conditions of asylum seekers in Switzerland. On 16th July 2021, while documenting the Afghan Special Forces mission to retake the town of Spin Boldak, Afghanistan, near the Pakistan border, the Taliban captured him, shot him dead, and then brutally mutilated his body, including running a Humvee over him.

Mr. Ashwin Prasad, Photojournalist, The New Indian Express was invited as the resource person for the second edition of the memorial lecture. The event started with invocation. Mr. Daniel S.R., student of II year Electronic Media led in prayer. The event was anchored by Mr. Nabeel Hussain, student of III year Visual Communication. A short Audio Visual prepared as a tribute to

- The observation of Solar system



The Disabilities enumerated as per RPWD Act (2016) are Blindness, Low-vision, Leprosy Cured persons, Hearing Impairment (deaf and hard of hearing), Locomotor Disability, Dwarfism, Intellectual Disability, Mental Illness, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophy, Chronic Neurological conditions, Specific Learning Disabilities, Multiple Sclerosis, Speech and Language disability, Thalassemia, Hemophilia, Sickle Cell disease, Multiple Disabilities including deafblindness, Acid Attack victim, Parkinson's disease and as per The National Trust (1999) Act, are Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities.

Summary:
