#### OBJECTIVES

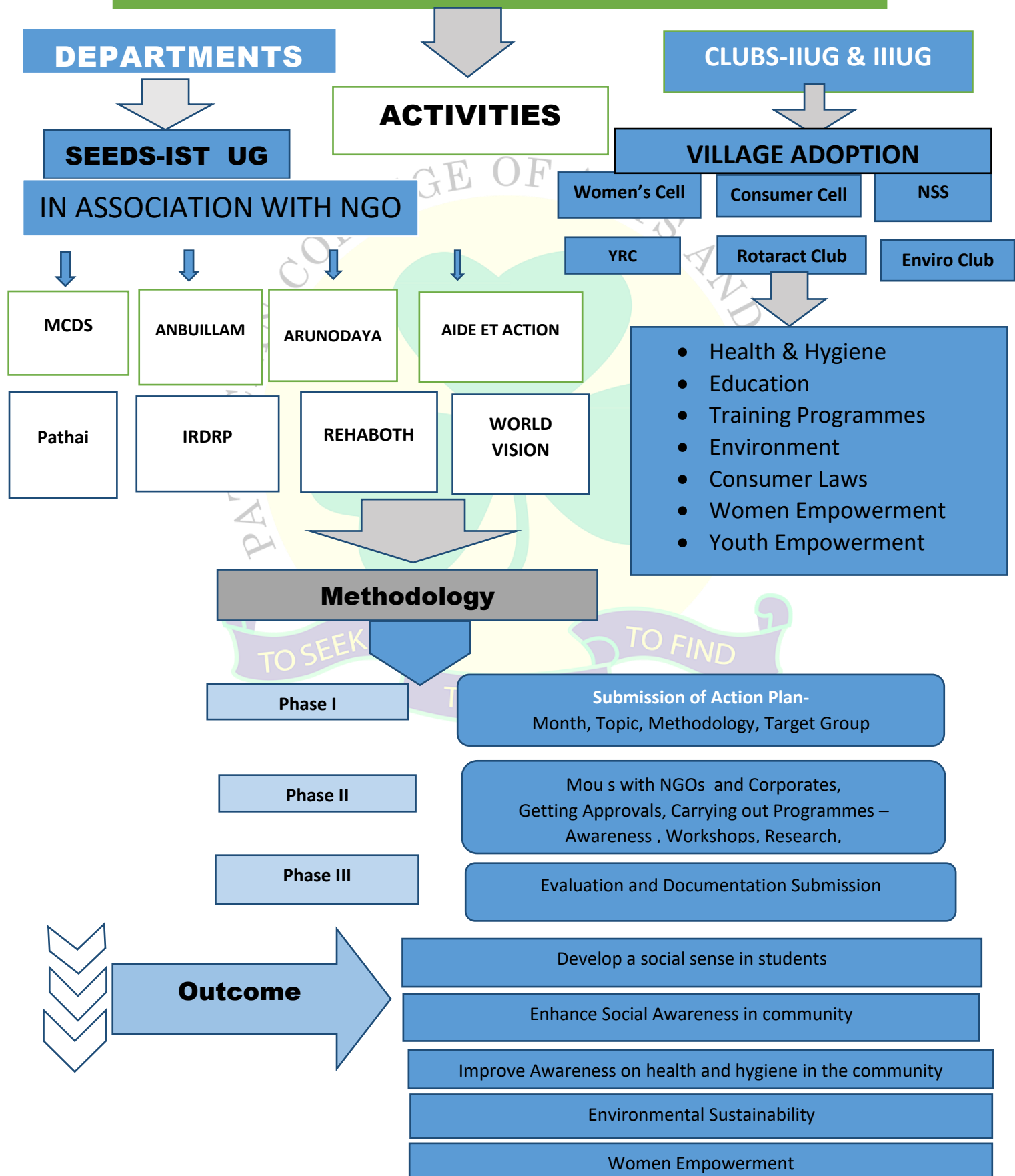
- To develop a sense of social justice, an interest, responsibility, compassion and concern in the students for and sensitivity to the difficulty of the underprivileged.

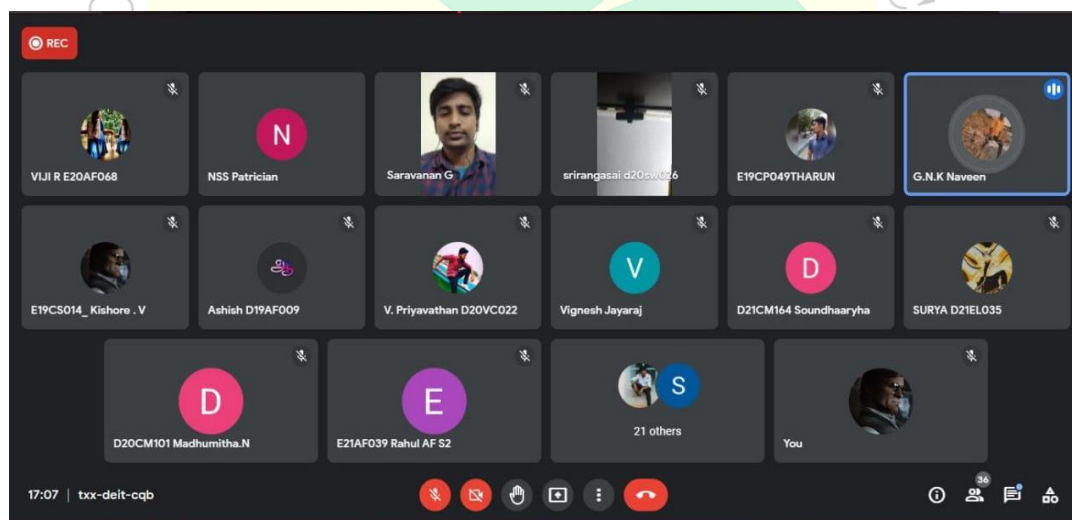
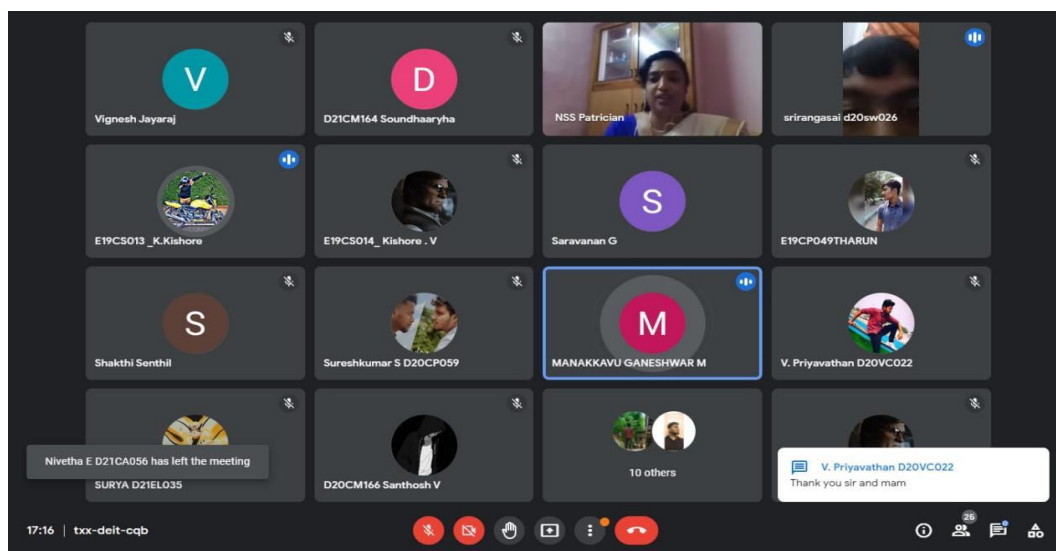

### PROGRAM SUMMARY:

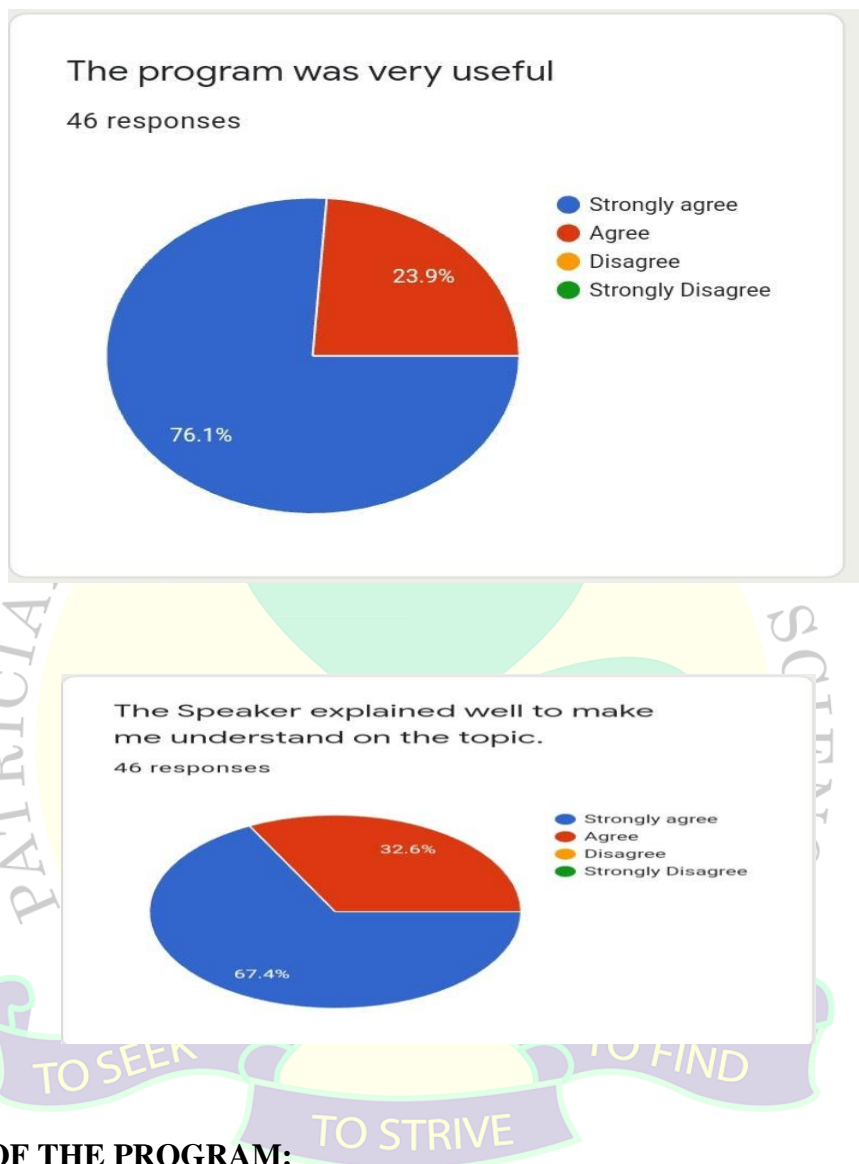

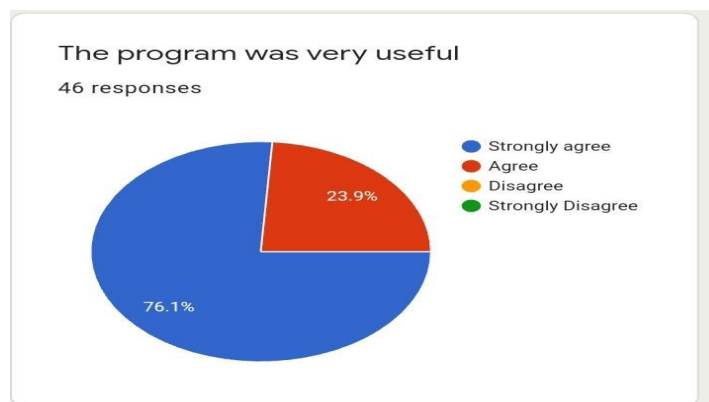
### PROGRAM SUMMARY:
