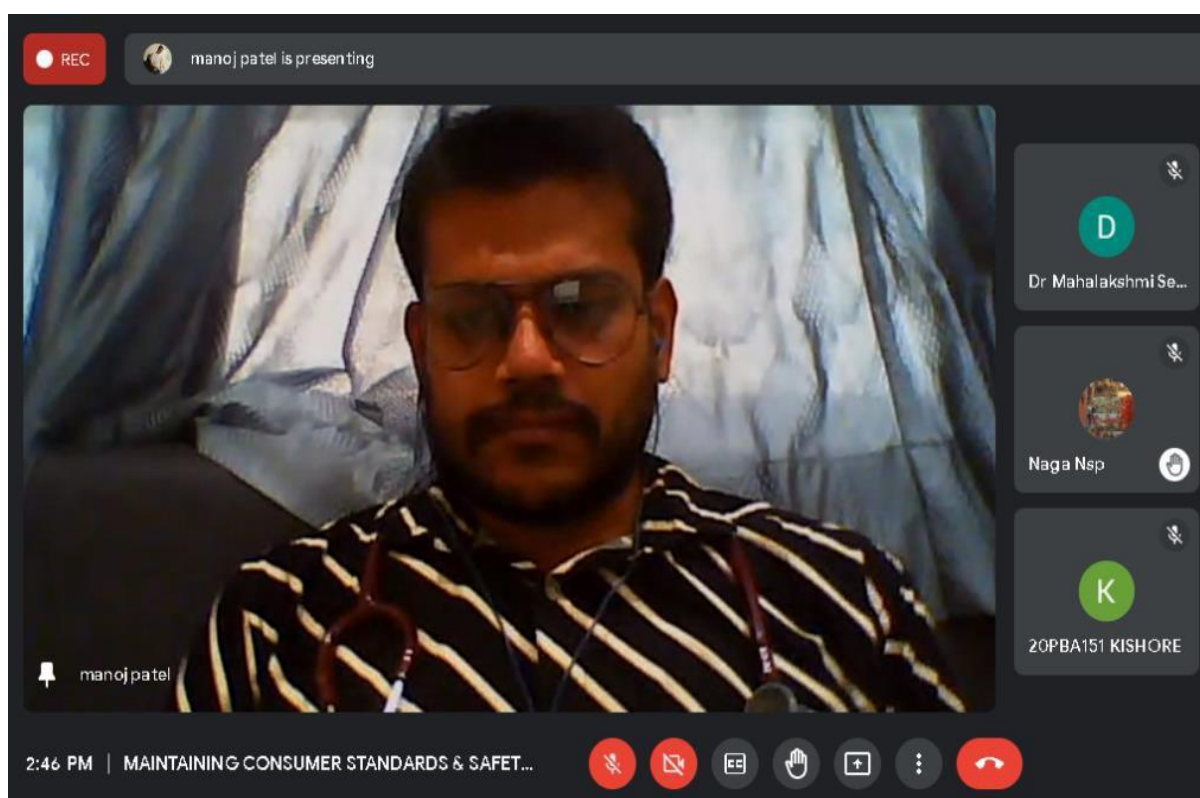


## Patrician Extension Activities for Community Empowerment

**Project Released by Dignitaries -PUBLIC OPINION ON COVID VACCINATION**

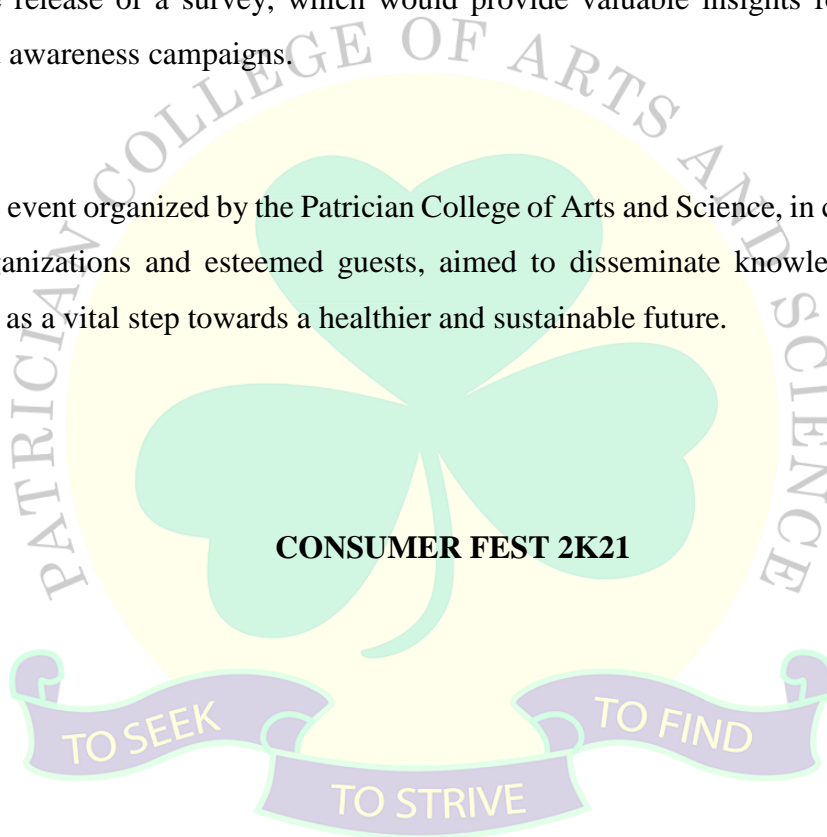

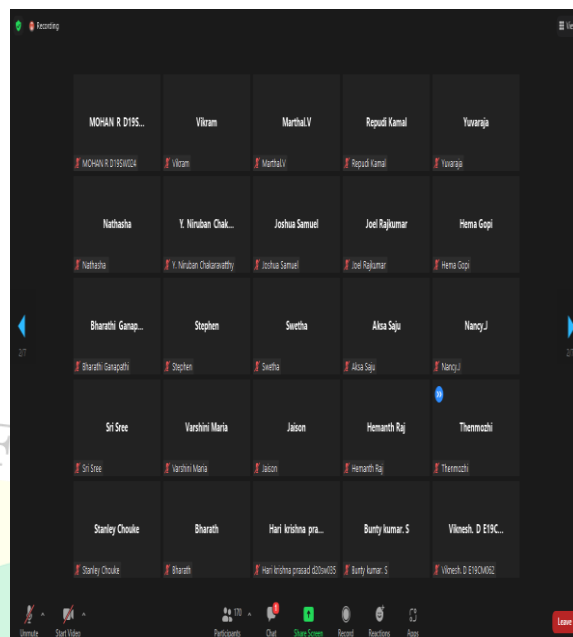
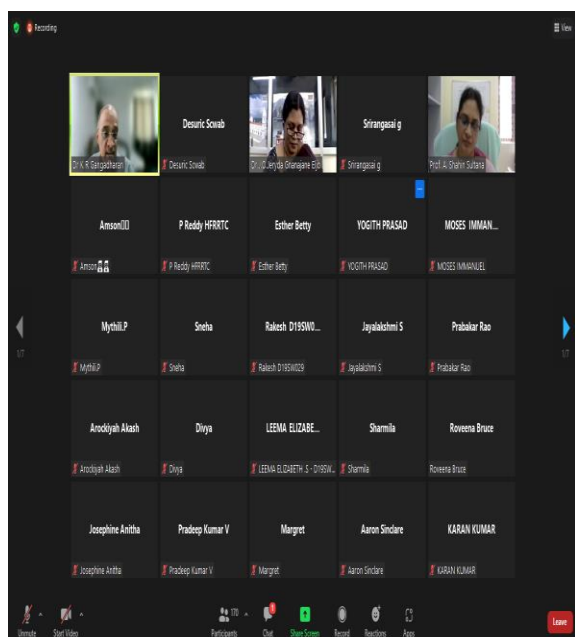
