Report on the Programme: Week 1

Icebreaker events like "Simon Says" and "Jumbled Words" were played. This helped the students to understand the importance of listening, coordinator, attentiveness and interaction with the student volunteers.

Later the SEEDS Team contributed 200 cloth masks for the students of 6th, 7th and 8th std.

Report on the Programme: Week 2

On the Second Week, the next set of volunteers with the SEEDSF Staff Team and the II M.A. Students arrived early at the venue. The theme for the Second Week was "Say No to Plastic". Plastic is one of the modern hazards of the 21st century. Starting early in bringing awareness to the students was important to any education.

Arun Kumar and Ajay Kumar of I B.A. English explained on the negative impact of using plastic. How plastic ends up in the landfill, among birds, insects, animals and marine species. The students explained how children should differentiate between single use plastic and regular plastic.

Report on the Programme: Week 6

Week 6 was the Valediction Day for the Seeds Outreach program as the students would be breaking for the Summer Holidays. The school had organized a thanksgiving note to the students and the staff coordinators. Tea and Refreshments were served. The Headmaster and the Assistant Headmaster appreciated the students for the marvelous patience and perseverance in teaching students basic social, moral values.

The College students performed a mime on the theme "Traffic Rules". We have every reason to believe that the students were impacted by the performance. A Qand A session was held for the students to find out what they had understood on the importance of traffic rules. The

response was amazing. The students also participated in some fun activities that would boost their interest in school education as well in learning.

Mention must be made that the students of the Govt High School belong to the low income category. Also other socio economic troubles also plague them particularly after the Covid. The students have lost 2 years of education because of lack of access to basic phones.
