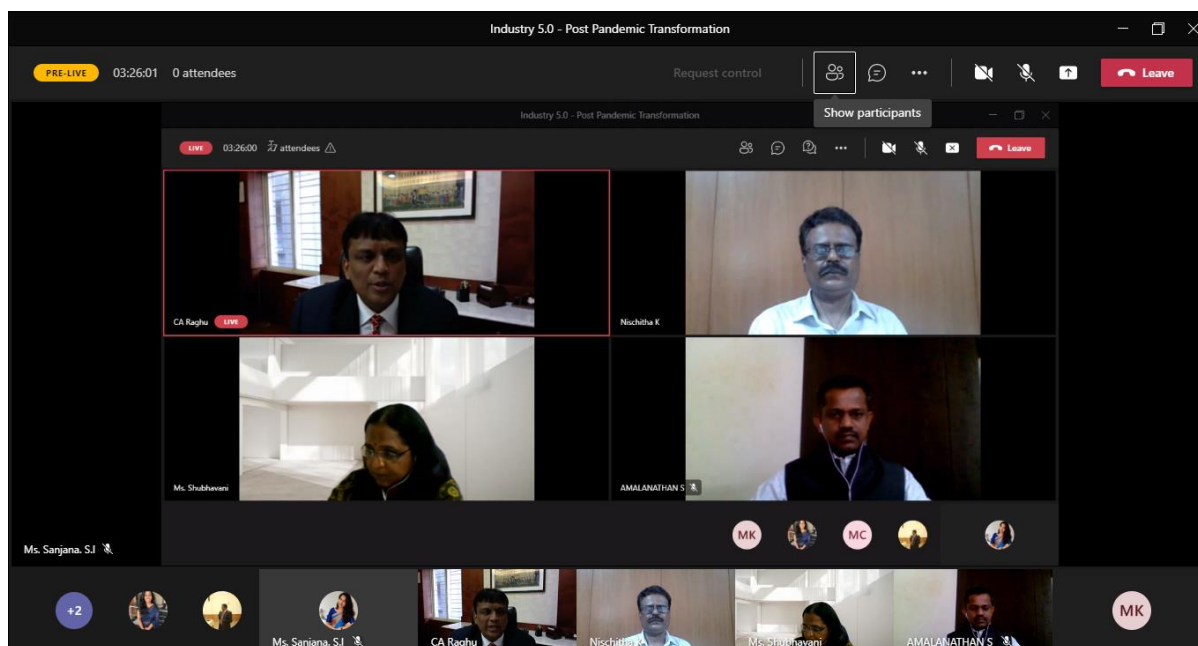

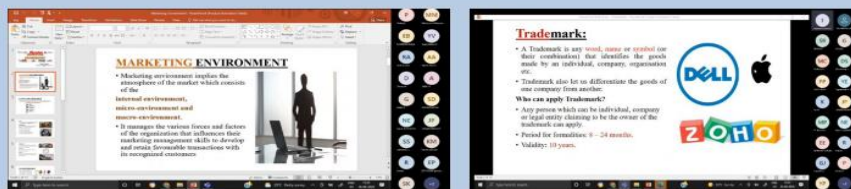

“ The Key to Success is Emotional Stability”

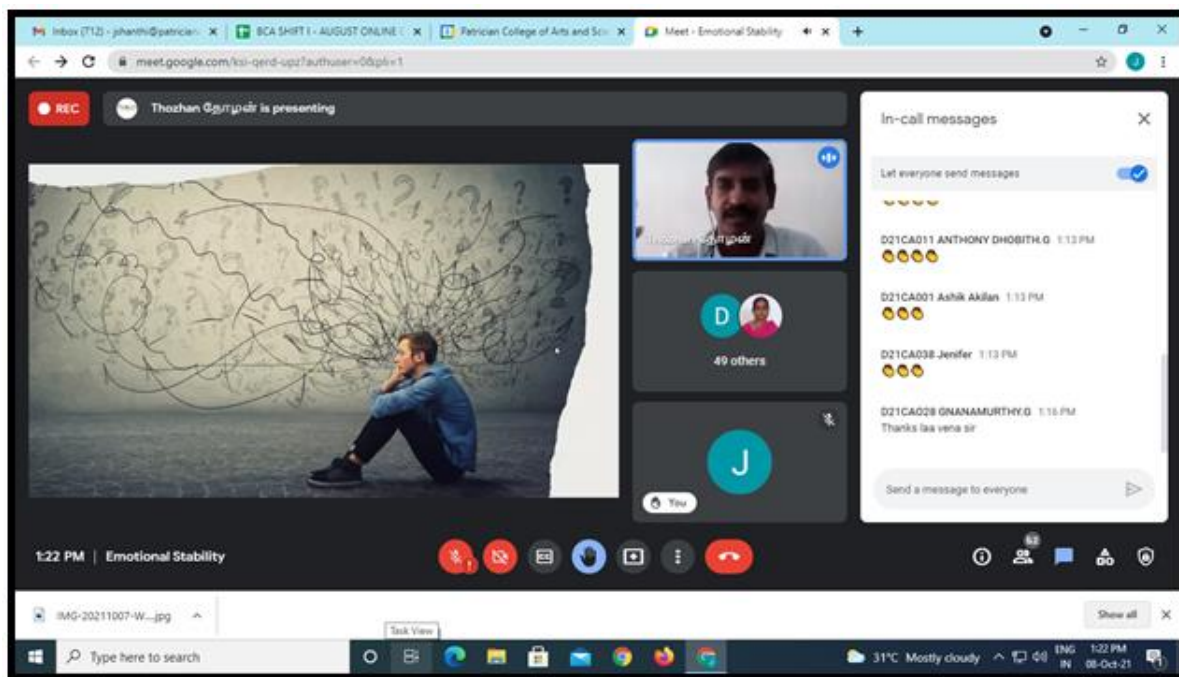

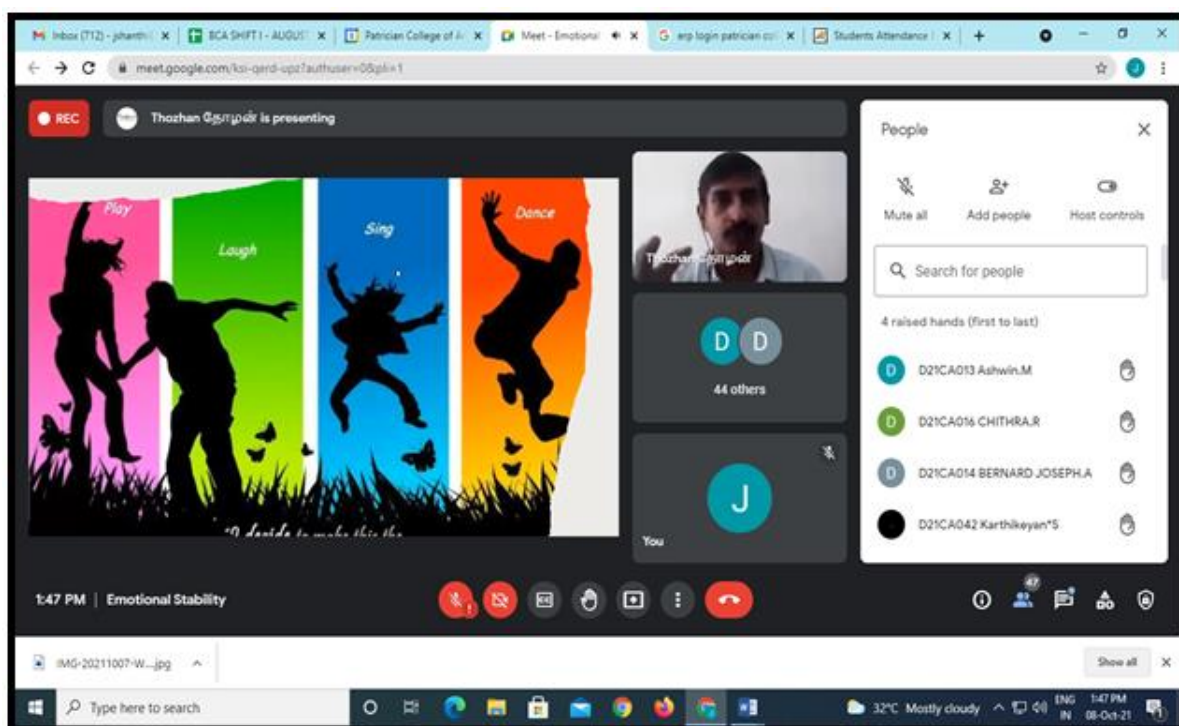




Mr. Radhakrishnan, Founder , Thozhan NGO sharing his views on need of emotional ability for college students


