PATRICIAN COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE, affiliated to the University of Madras, G.O.No.168.20.04.2001 having its main campus at Canal Bank Road, Gandhi Nagar, Adyar, Chennai 600 020, Tamil Nadu, India (henceforth referred to as "**PCAS**") of the other part.

TAR UC and **PCAS** shall where the context so permits, hereinafter refer to singularly as "Party" and jointly as "the Parties".

WHEREAS

- A. The Parties are desirous of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding in order to enable the Parties to share common and fundamental objectives of promoting and developing higher education opportunities in the Parties countries.
- B. The Parties shall at all times for the common benefit of the Parties hereto use their best endeavour to ensure the success of this Memorandum of Understanding.

PURSUANT THERETO, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

OBJECTIVES

- 1.1 Subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding, the Parties heretoagree to facilitate academic research and development exchanges between the Parties, including mutual visits and cooperation by faculty members to pursue teaching, conduct research, joint supervision of postgraduate students, programmes development and other academic activities.
- 1.2 To provide members for the Parties' staff, alumni, graduates and students the opportunity to pursue higher education programmes that lead to the award of qualifications awarded by each Party on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

SEPARATE ARRANGEMENTS

2.1 Both Parties agree that all the physical and financial arrangements for any of the cooperation envisaged herein in this Memorandum of Understanding will be negotiated and agreed upon separately and will depend upon the availability of funds and resources. 3.1 **TAR UC** and **PCAS** reserves its rights and claim of ownership and/or intellectual property rights in all documents and materials that are first supplied for thepurposes of pursuing this Memorandum of Understanding which such documents and materials are not the joint results arising out of and or envisaged as such from this Memorandum of Understanding.

PUBLICITY

- 4.1 The Parties may report on and publicize the positive application of the inputs and corroborative results (if any) arising from this Memorandum for educational and/or academic purposes, subject to prior written approval from the Parties for each of the party's publicity activities.
- 4.2 Both Parties, subject always to a prior written consent, further consents to each other that the respective Party's name and logo may be included in marketing activities.

DURATION

- 5.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall be for a term of 3 years.
 - 5.2 The Parties may agree to extend the Memorandum of Understanding for a further period or periods to such dates as may be agreed in writing.

CONFIDENTIALITY

6.1 Neither Party shall, at any time, disclose to any third party, any confidential information of the other Party which is acquired pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding, without the prior written consent of that particular other Party.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

7.1 The parties hereto agree that notwithstanding anything contained in this Memorandum of Understanding, disputes arising or relating to this Memorandum of Understanding shall be resolved amicably between the parties by negotiations.

TERMINATION

8.1 This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either Party by giving the other Party a notice in writing one (1) months' before termination, or sooner upon mutual written consent of the Parties.

NON-LEGAL OBLIGATION

9.1 This Memorandum of Understanding forms the present intentions of the Parties between them and shall not be legally binding upon the Parties in relation to any of the activities specified in this Memorandum of Understanding until and unless legally binding agreements are entered into between the Parties hereafter to consummate any of the activities contemplated herein.

- 10.1 This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time by mutual consent made in writing between the Parties hereto.
- 10.2 Nothing in this Memorandum of Understanding shall prejudice the right of both

Parties to establish similar relationship with other institutions.

- 10.3 The Parties agree to bear their own legal and other cost incurred in relation to the preparation, negotiation and execution of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 10.4 Nothing in this Memorandum of Understanding shall diminish the authority and autonomy vested in the Parties hereto.

10.5 Neither the TAR UC nor the PCAS has acted in breach of the Malaysian Anti Corruption Commission Act, 2009 and or S.17A thereunder or any other applicable laws for the prevention of fraud, bribery, corruption, money laundering or terrorism. Both Parties hereto covenant and undertake with one another that each of them shall not, in connection with their respective business and the Agreement between them hereto, promise, authorize, ratify, encourage or offer to make, or to act in furtherance

of any payment, contributions, gifts, entertainment, hospitality, travel, reimbursement, kickback or any other valuable consideration whether explicitly or implicitly to unjustly enriched any individuals from the TAR UC or the PCAS to the exclusion of the TAR UC and or the PCAS hereunder. The TAR UC and the PCAS, have not or to their respective knowledge or cognizance any members of the Board, Shareholders, Management, Officers, employees or associated personnel, as the case may be, established or maintained any unrecorded funds or asset forany purposes detrimental to the respective Party's interests under this agreement.

10.6 The PCAS hereby covenants and undertakes that in the event the PCAS breached the obligations under the above Clause, or any other such undertakings with the TAR UC during the course of its business with the TAR UC under this Agreement the TAR UC shall, notwithstanding anything to the contrary under this Agreement, be entitled forthwith to suspend or terminate this Agreement with the PCAS.
