INTRODUCTION

Recently the terms "governance" and "good governance" are being increasingly used in development literature. An exhaustive database of MPs and MLAs who are contesting elections (including their educational qualifications, criminal record etc.), and a campaign feature, where citizens can draw the attention of their local representatives to civic issues, are the crowning features of this platform. Also, users are free to submit articles to share their opinions, and engage in discussion forums on topics that are of importance. Through YUVA, she has recently organized a national seminar on "Celebrating Secularism" in collaboration with Loyola college. To infuse politics with the much needed academic rigor, Aishwarya is working towards building a leadership institute, where aspiring young politicians will be trained by the best minds in the country for a career in politics.

Through these education, empowerment and leadership initiatives at YUVA, Aishwarya has only begun to work towards her vision of bringing political advocacy back in vogue. Armed with a clear vision to take YUVA to every part of the country, and build a reliable name for her not for profit enterprise, Aishwarya stands as a clear example of the fact that business interests need not be divorced from social responsibility.


