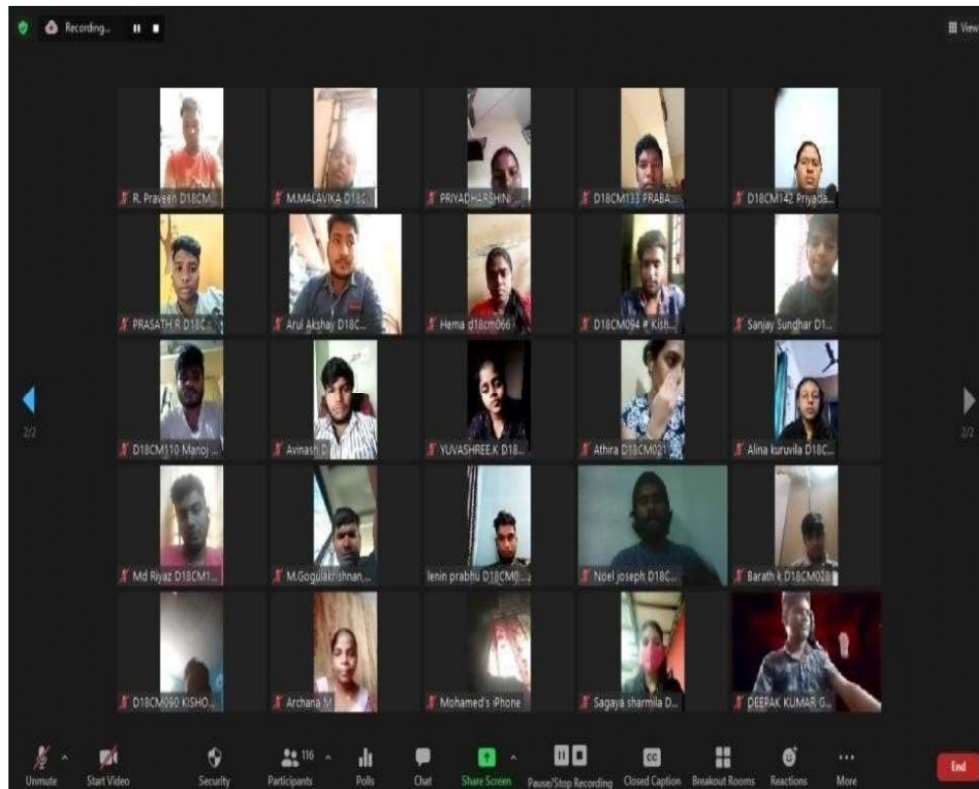
### LOGISTICS AND SHIPPING MANAGEMENT

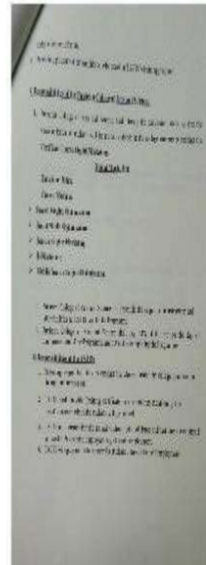

## ETHICAL HACKING AND CYBER SECURITY

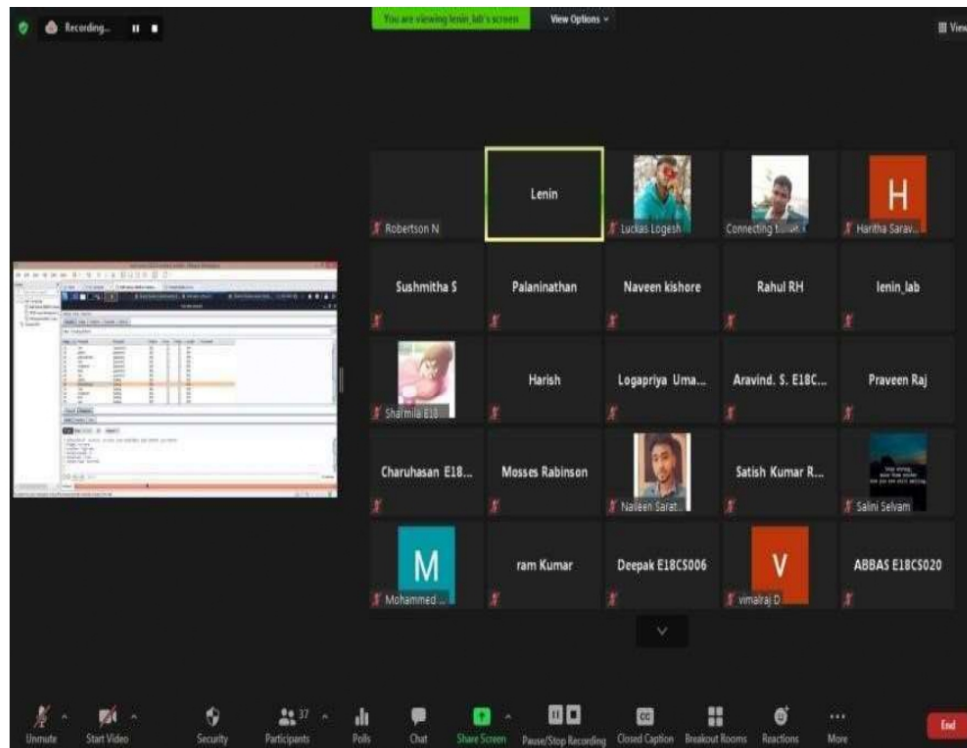
### ABOUT THE COURSE:

**ETHICAL HACKING AND CYBER SECURITY**

**ABOUT THE COURSE:** Ethical hacking is generally a process involves an authorized attempt of gaining the unauthorized access to another system, application or data whereas Cyber Security is a process of securing the networks, devices or programs by the unauthorized access through technology. 

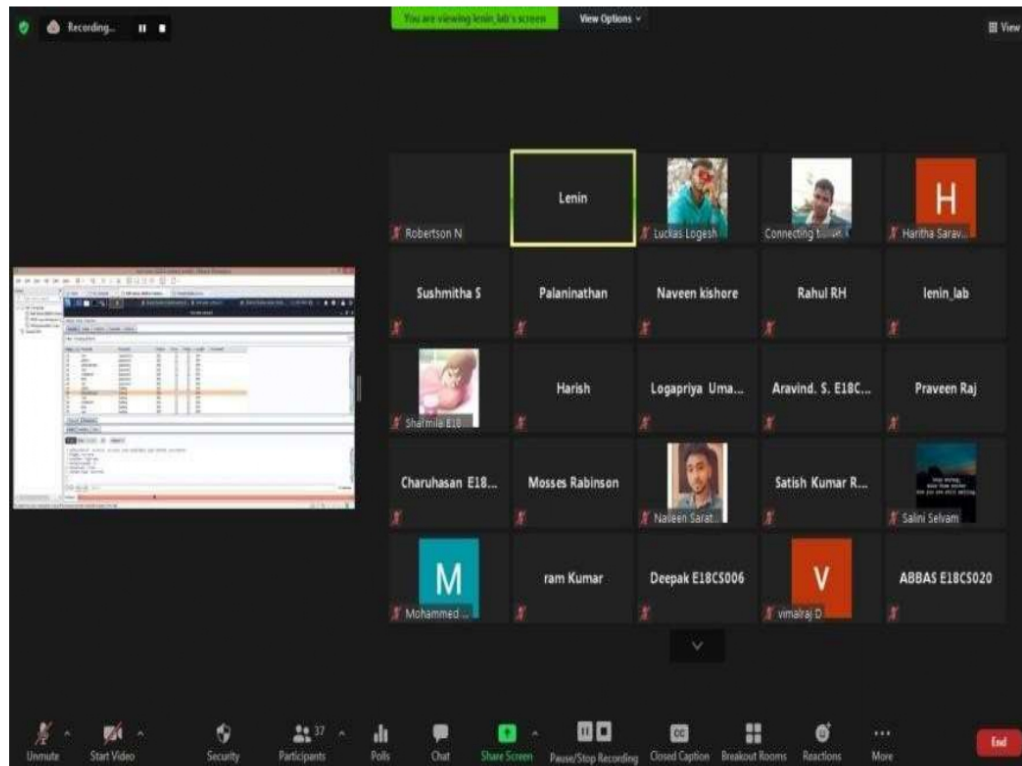

### INTRODUCTION

Recently the terms "governance" and "good governance" are being increasingly used in development literature. Bad governance is being increasingly regarded as one of the root causes of all evil within our societies. Major donors and international financial institutions are increasingly basing their aid and loans on the condition that reforms that ensure "good governance" are undertaken.

The concept of "governance" is not new. It is as old as human civilization. Simply put "governance" means: the process of decision-making and the process by which decisions are implemented (or not implemented). Governance can be used in several contexts such as corporate governance, international governance, national governance and local governance. Since governance is the process of decision making and the process by which decisions are implemented, an analysis of governance focuses on the formal and informal actors involved in decision-making and implementing the decisions made and the formal and informal structures that have been set in place to arrive at and implement the decision.
