Objective of the programme:

In order to provide students with the basic knowledge about how to plan a start-up and the steps to be taken toward achieving goals, Department of Corporate Secretaryship organized a session on the topic-"How to plan for start-up? Legal & Ethical Steps" along with Institution's Innovation Council,

On 4th August 2023, the session on "How to plan for start-up and legal & ethical steps, on world intellectual property day. This session is scheduled to instill the legal and ethical steps that should follow in the business. Mr Balaji Varadhan, Founder of Village Business School facilitated this session. She began with a mythology story as the base illustration for this session. He said, "A business idea is like a coffee mug filled to the top." Resource person Mr Mr Balaji Varadhan, explained how starting a business or registering the company, splitting the company by founder and co-founder, and many back-end processes are carried out when an investor proposes. Overall, it clarifies the team of co-founders, investors, incubators, and promoters and determines the types of business structures using numerous examples such as sole-proprietorship, general, limited liability partnership, private limited company, and non-profit company. He discussed the various fees that must be paid when registering a company. She exemplified how we could create more intellectual property while developing and guarding a business idea. He mentioned how we could



have a "Right Legal Counsel Matter" when we are in trouble as business owners. He also discusses the various types of deposits, loan moratorium periods, intellectual property rights for animals (used as an example, i.e., Naruto monkey), licensing, permit issues, and how terms differ from country to country. He talked about how there can be issues with data protection, privacy, advertising and marketing, and various contracts. She finally concluded the session by discussing Tortious Liabilities, Ethical Liabilities, and many more issues that may arise due to counterfeiting our products and problems with labor laws. The questions written by the participants were cleared out by the end of the session. Eventually, he received a vote of thanks for providing insights on legal & ethical steps in start-ups.






Resource Person Dr Kumaresan M has explained about Review of Literature Hypothesis

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







Outcome of the Programme

These resources can be tangible or intangible, such as human capital, financial assets, physical infrastructure, or intellectual property Business Model Canvas Advantages
