She interacted with us asking these questions and then she told about Research methodology

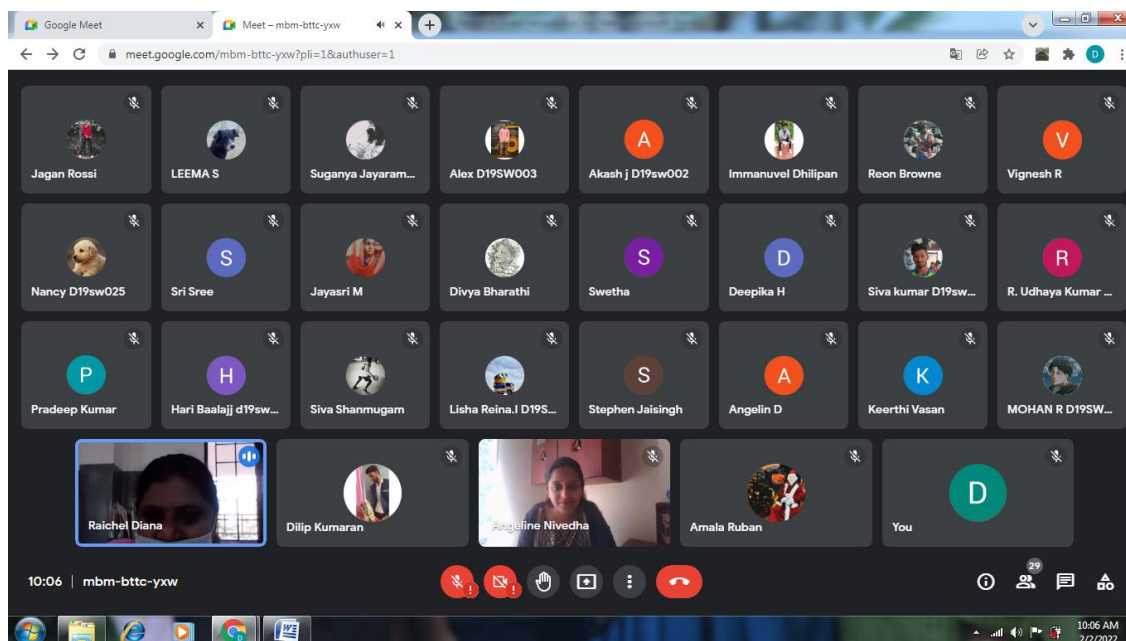

Then she explained about the types of sampling

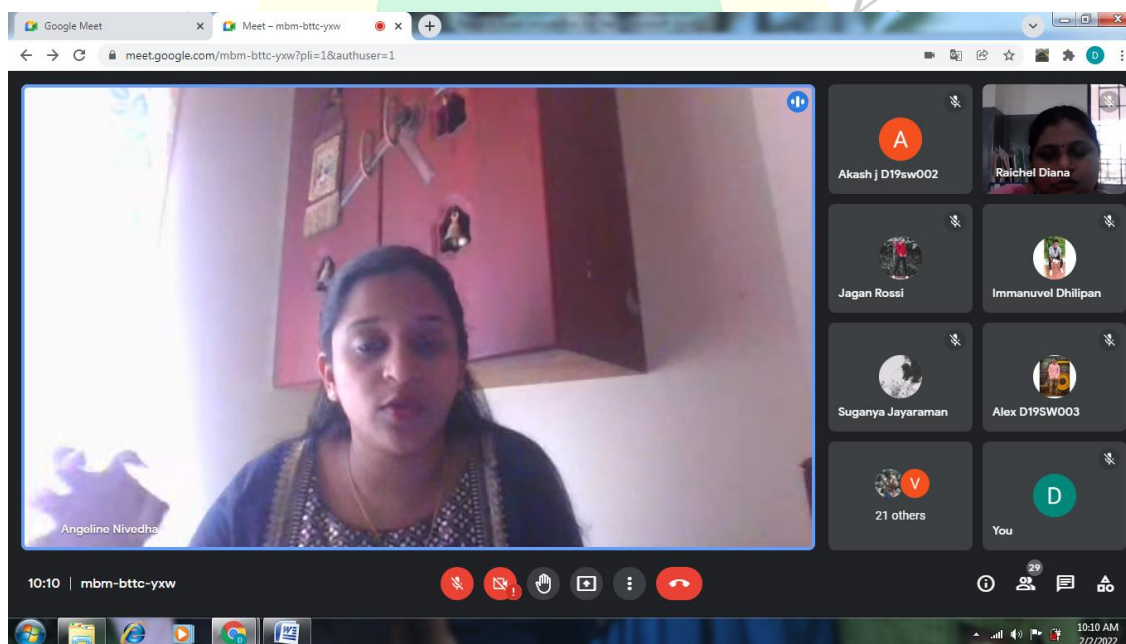

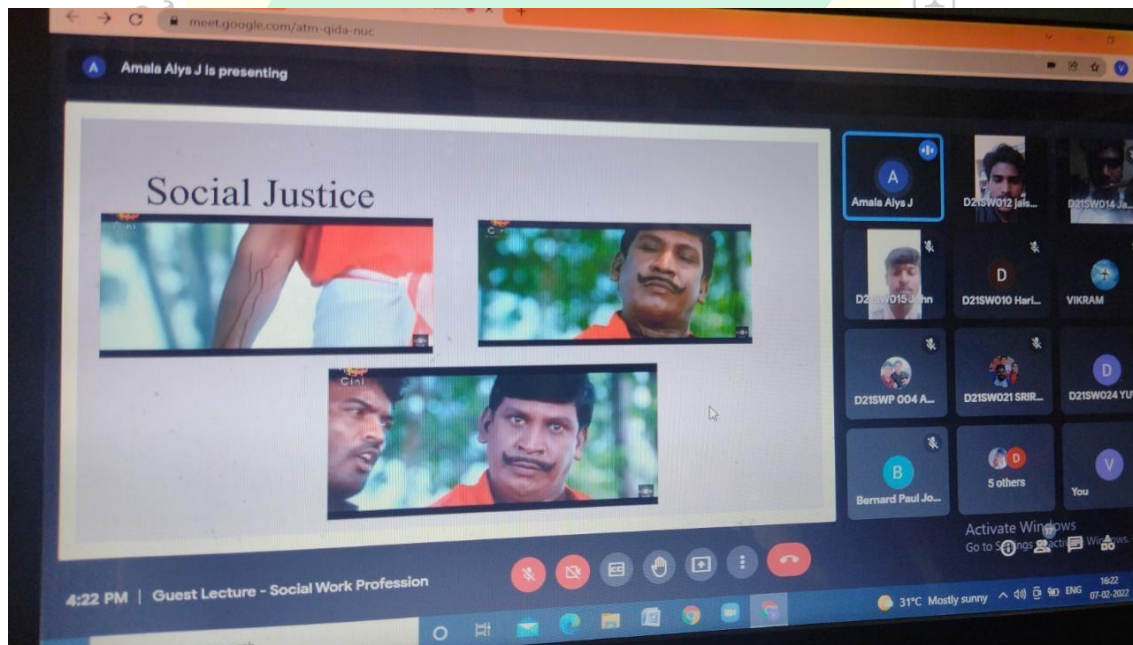
She also spoke about the importance of self-awareness and controlled emotional involvement. She also shared her personal experiences and made the students understand the importance of communication and how staying away from negativity

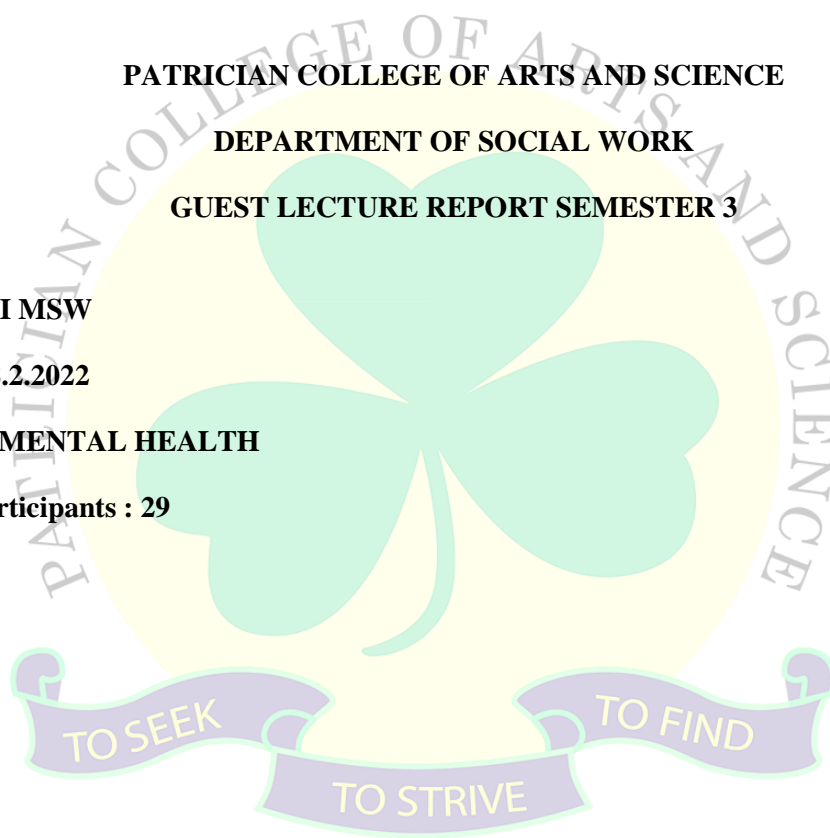

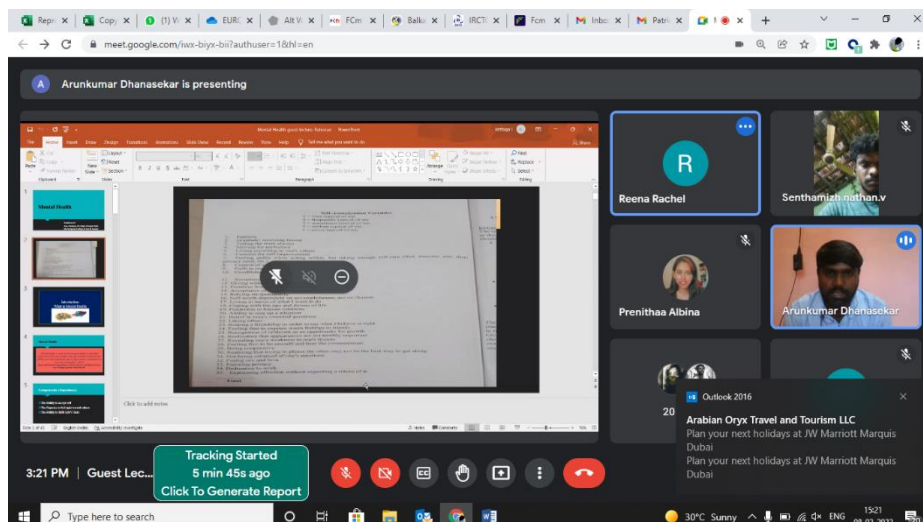

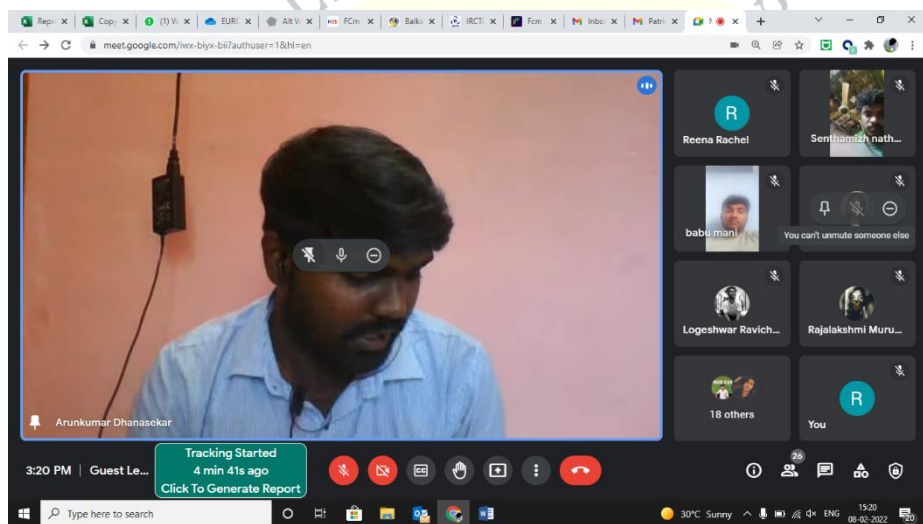
### Summary of the program

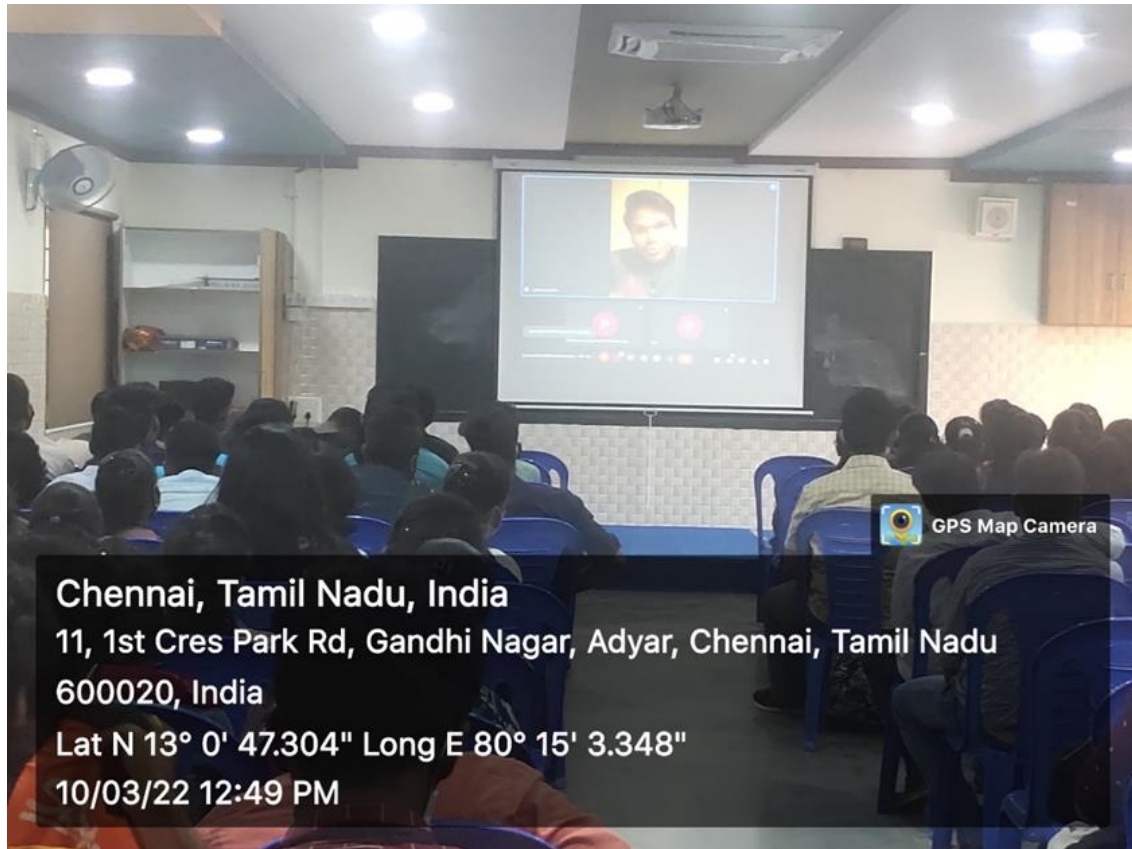

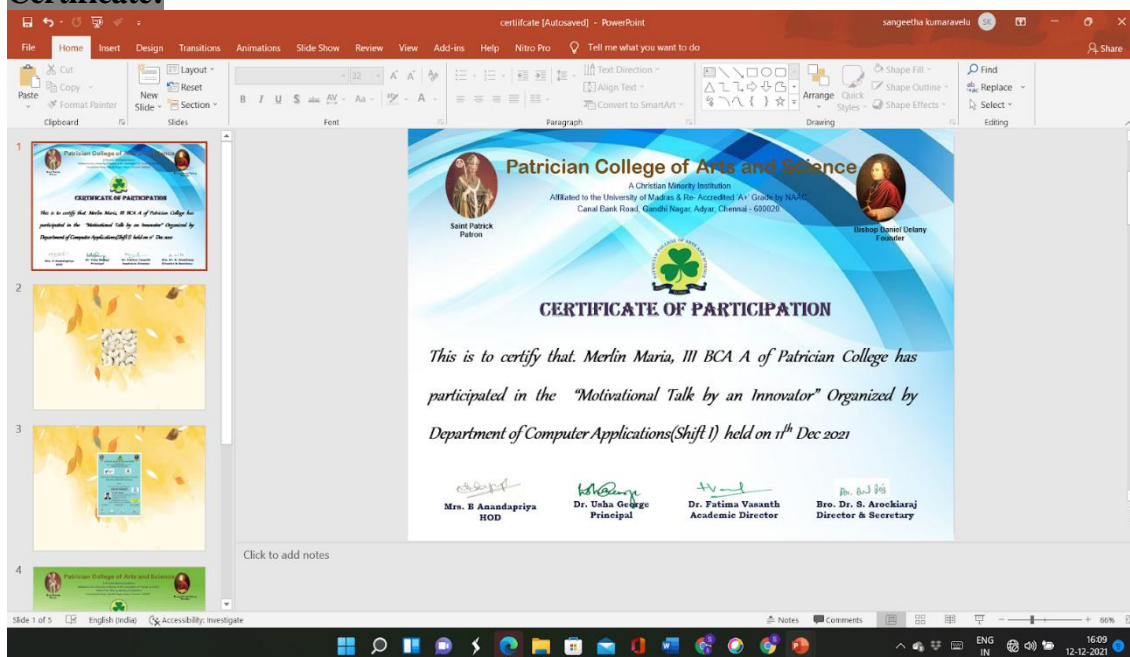
#### Programme Report

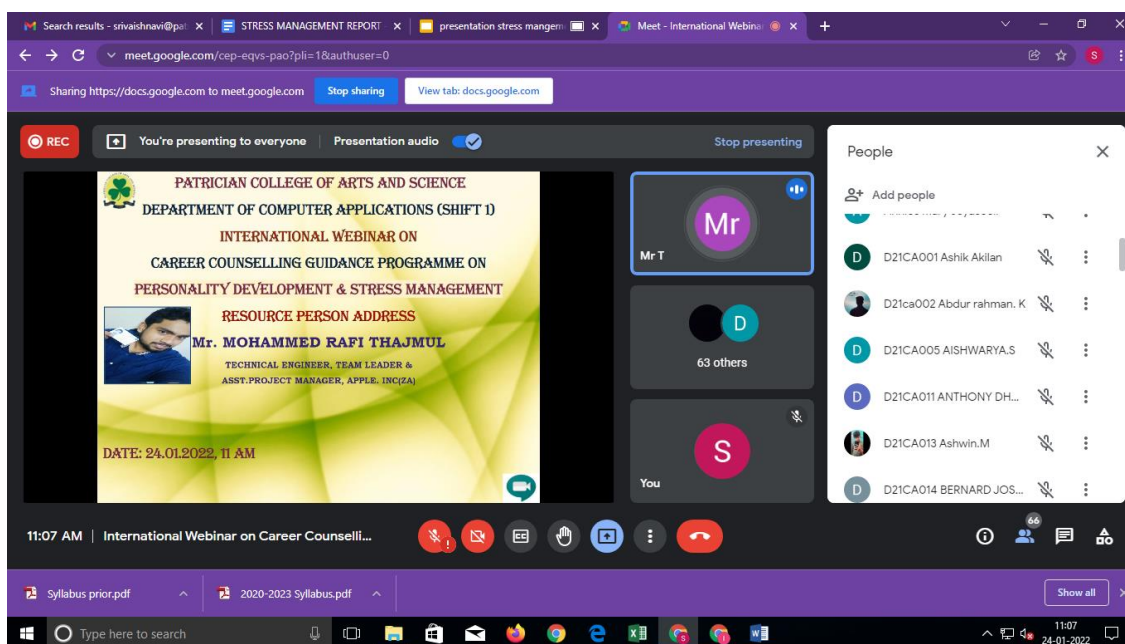

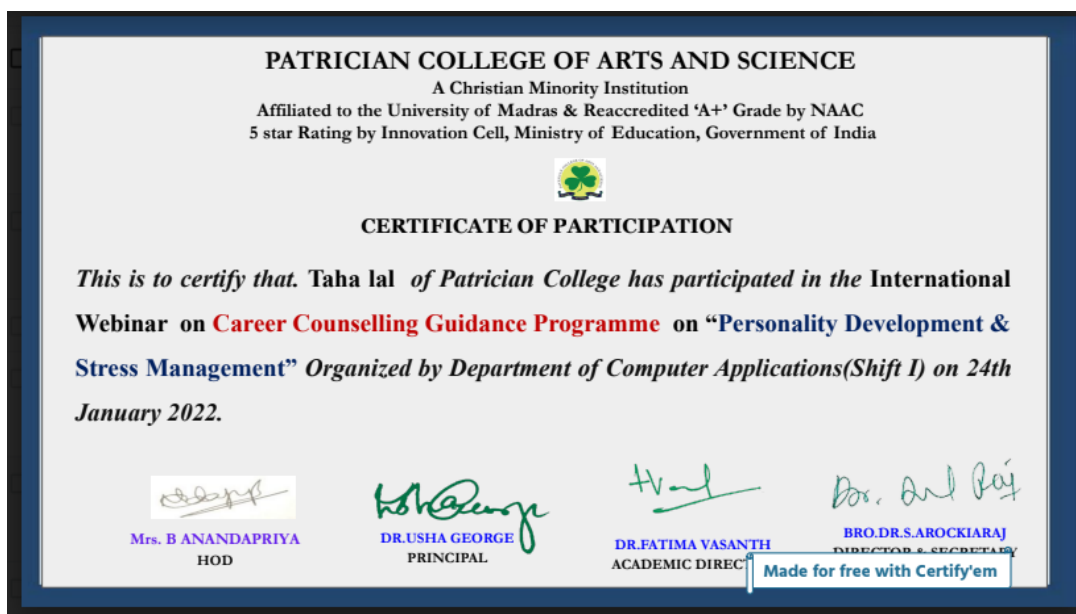

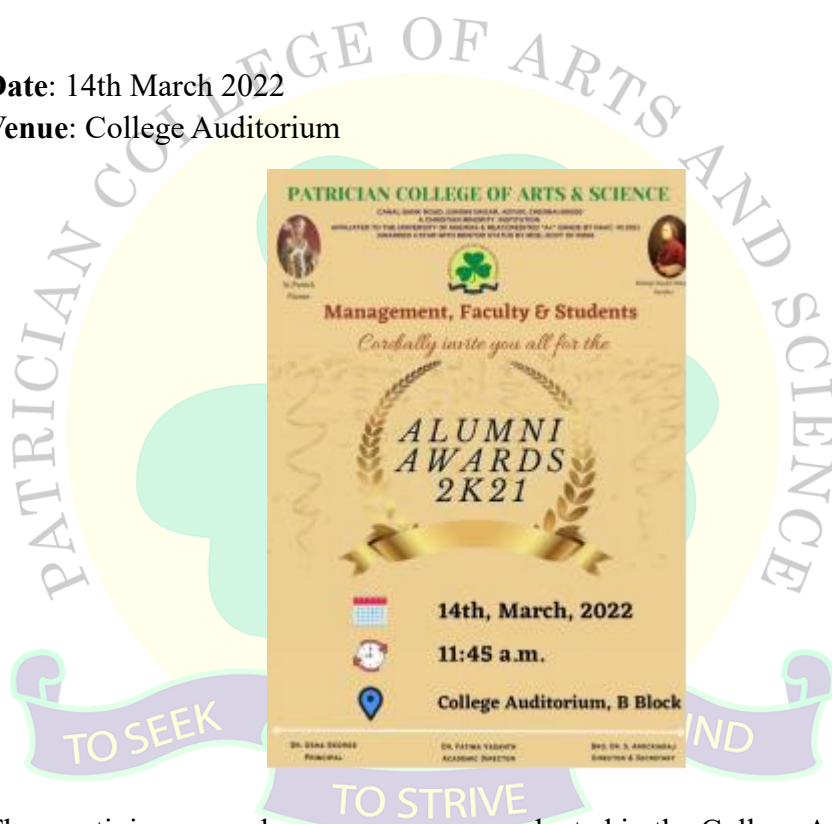
### Alumni Meeting Report for the Academic Year 2021-2022

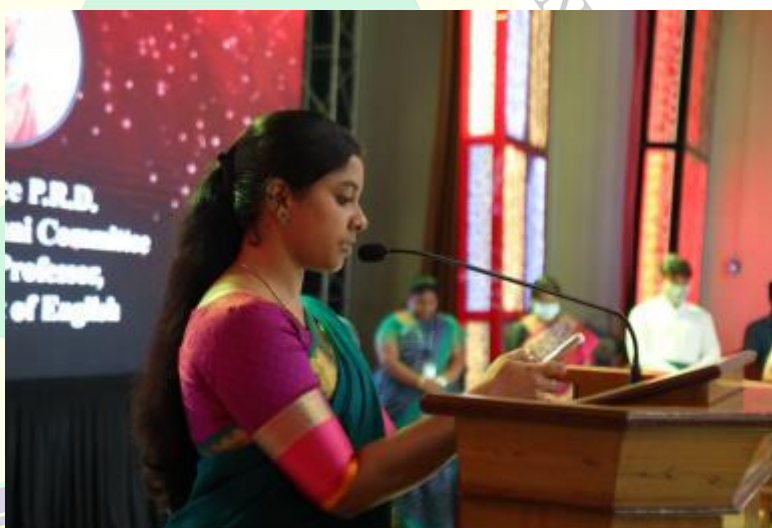
