### Outcome of the Programme

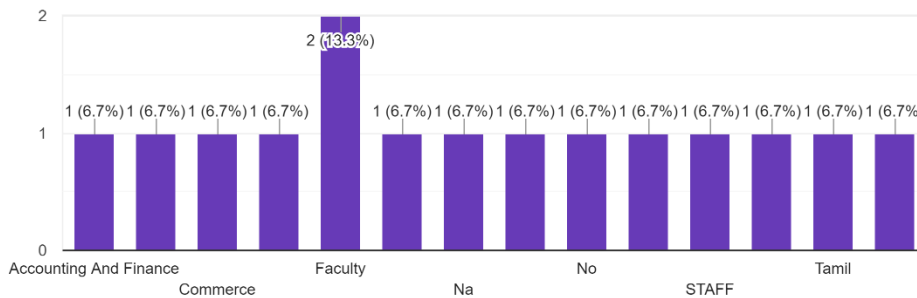
