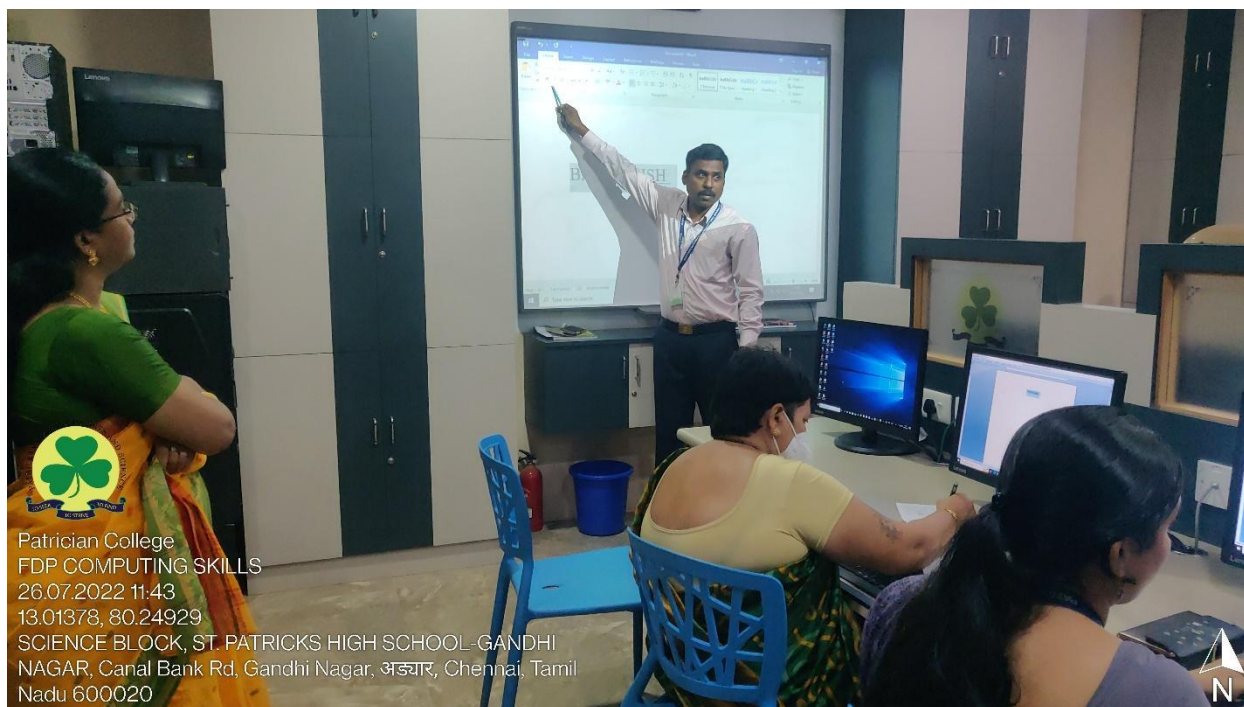
**About SDP Series:**

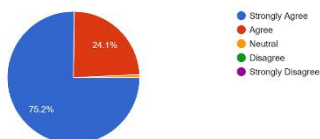
### Report:

## COMPONENTS OF THE TRAINING

### Transect Walk - Mr. Prasanna

A Social Survey involves obtaining information standardized from large groups of people. The main survey methods are questionnaires and structured interviews.

### Social Mapping – Ms. Raichel Diana

Social mapping is a visual method of showing the relative location of households and the distribution of different people (such as male, female, adult, child, landed, landless, literate, and illiterate) together with the social structure, groups and organizations of an area.

### Venn Diagram – Ms. Raichel Diana

A Venn diagram is an illustration that uses circles to show the relationships among things or finite groups of things. Circles that overlap have a commonality while circles that do not overlap do not share those traits. Venn diagrams help to visually represent the similarities and differences between two concepts.

### **Problem Tree Analysis – Mr. Justus Wallis**

The problem tree, together with the objective tree and analysis of strategies, is a methodology of three steps for identifying main problems, along with their causes and effects, helping project planners to formulate clear and manageable objectives and the strategies of how to achieve them.

### **Focus Group Discussion – Mr. Justus Wallis**

Focus group discussion is frequently used as a qualitative approach to gain an in-depth understanding of social issues. The method aims to obtain data from a purposely selected group of individuals rather than from a statistically representative sample of a broader population.

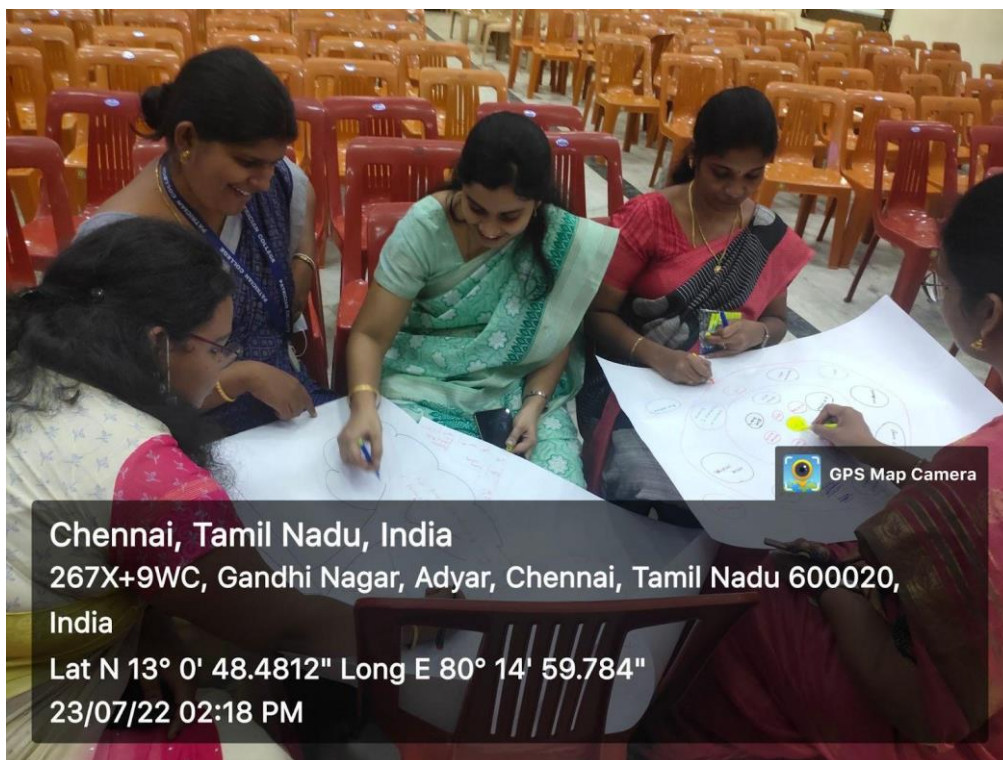

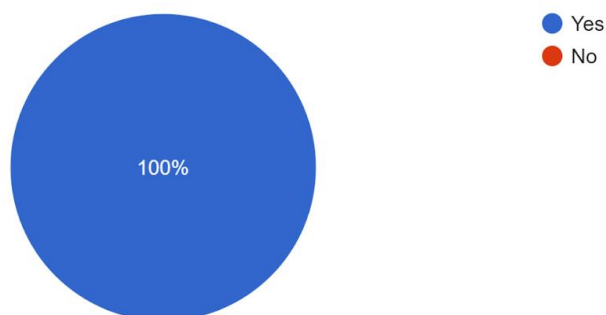

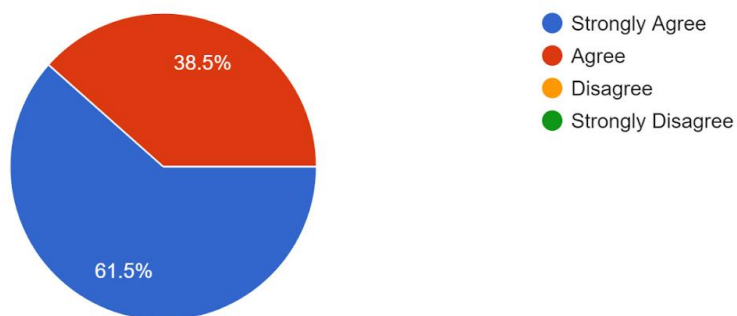
