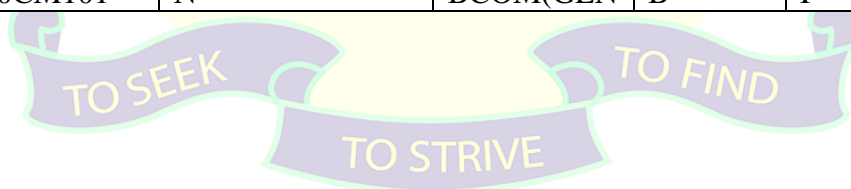

An additional E block has been included with the existing college facility, which comprises of 22 class rooms - 2 Conference Halls and 1 Lab to enhance teaching – learning facilities.

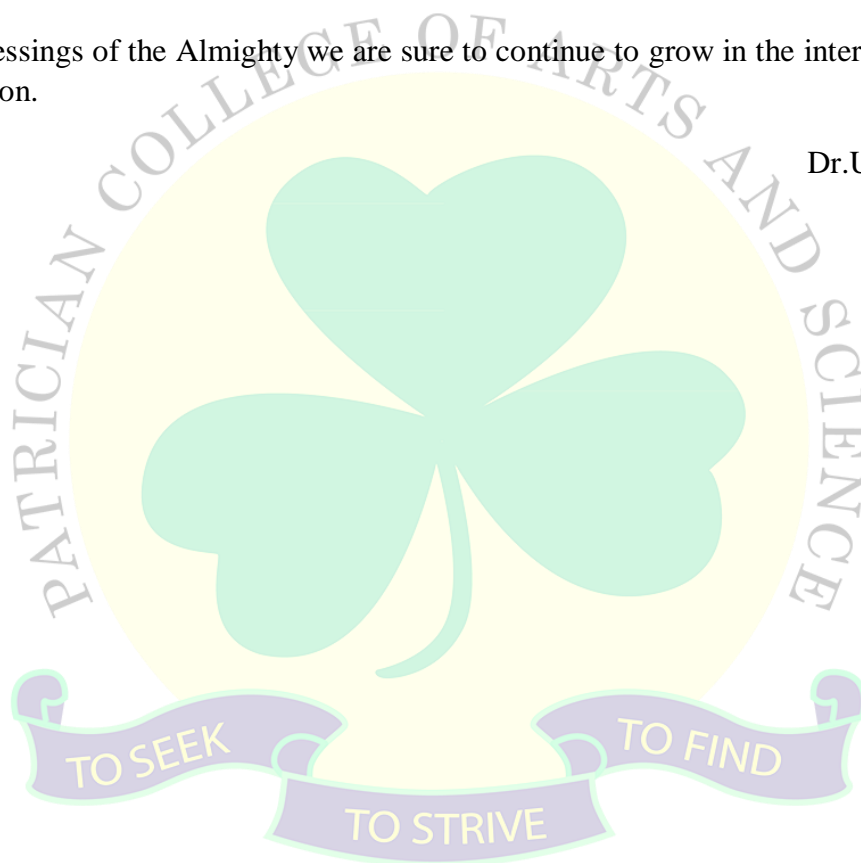
