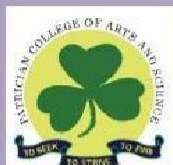


Feedback

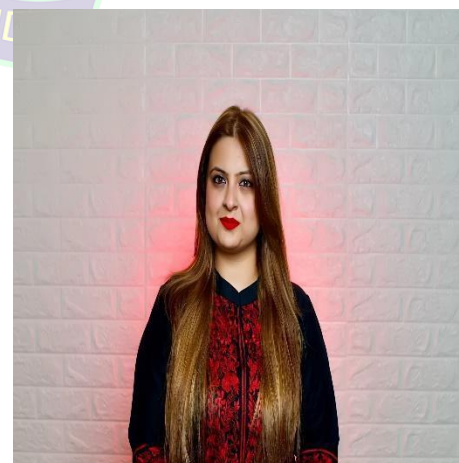

session offered training inputs and helped them to learn and acquire new skills and competencies through various activities such as mock interviews, group discussions, aptitude tests, expert lectures etc.

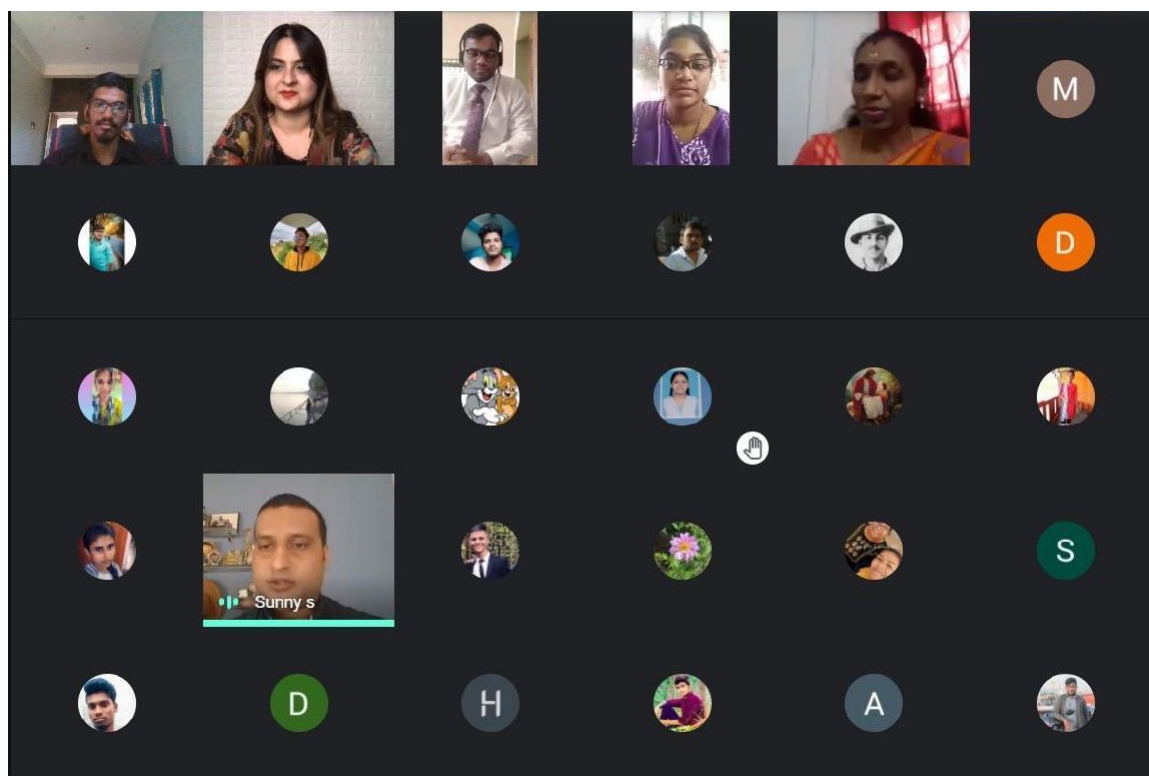

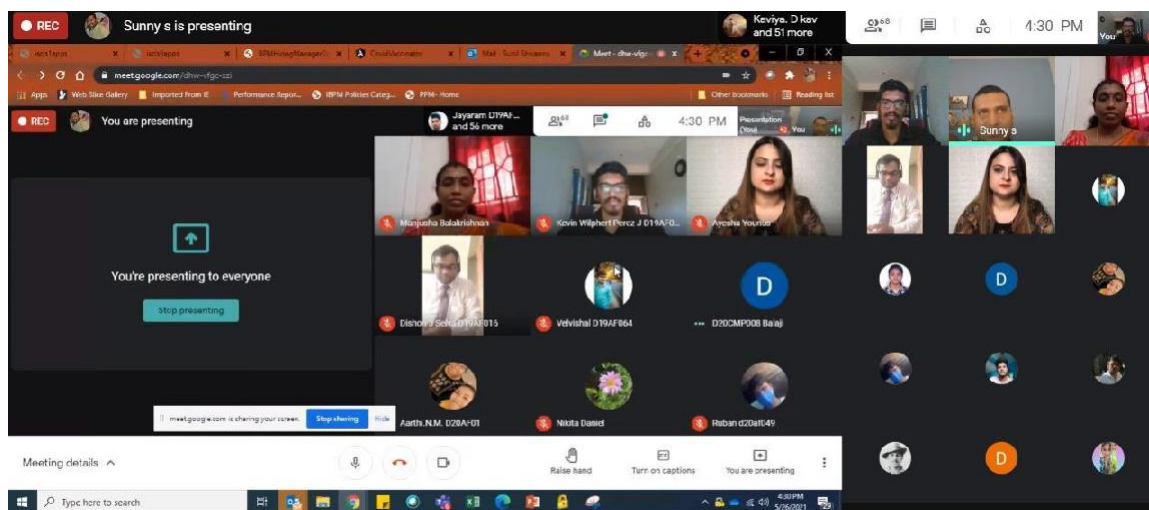

Outcome



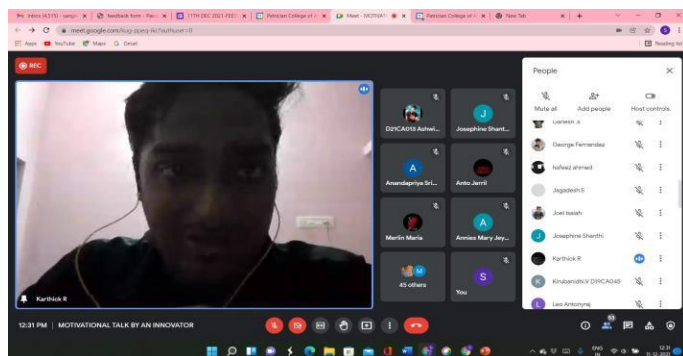
Programme Objective:




Report:

The Department of Computer Applications and Patrician Institution's Innovation Council conducted a webinar on "Motivational session on successful innovations" on Tuesday, 28th December 2021. The resource person for the day was Dr. Valli, Head of R & D, Manakula Vinayagar Institute and Technology.

The resource person started the session with the quote "There **is no way to do better just find it**", she encouraged students to find new things and explained what is invention and innovations and then she gave the difference between innovation and invention and added "Necessity is mother of Invention and commercialization and creativity are parents of innovation. The resource person added the invention is a new solution to a technical problem and it must be protected by patents. She said the four important inventions are The light bulb, combustion engine, telephone, Computer. The resource person explained clearly the need for incubation and patent. She clearly explained the step by step procedure to start a start-up company in India. She insisted the business plan must have Company description, strategy, business model, management and organization, marketing plan, operational plan and financial plan. She said difference between partnership and proprietorship and insisted to get help from an advocate to make it as a private limited company. She advised to register using start up India to get more sponsors and funding. She gave five steps like project idea generation, convert concept to ideas, prototype phase, IPR Evaluation and getting patent and Marketing. She explained what is trade mark, patent, copyrights and she explained what is the validity of the patent. The resource person listed her inventions like automatic water dispenser, automatic sensor taps. Saline Solution Monitoring and Alerting Device. She shared her experience how they got the idea and how it was executed.







 Maintaining and monitoring the level of saline solution in the bottle remotely is very demanding during this pandemic situation.
 If the saline solution for intravenous infusion gets over and the bottle is empty and the needle is not removed from the vein, then the blood flows outward into the bottle.
 Almost in all hospitals, assistants/nurses are responsible for monitoring the Dextrose Normal Saline (DNS) fluid level system.
 But during situations when the doctor/nurse forgets or delays to change or stop the infusion of IV at appropriate times, it may lead to ill-effects to the patients.

Problem

 The IV infusion method is vulnerable to human error. i.e., it poses a risk of backflow of blood if unattended when the IV bottle is empty.




Mushroom Production Map of Tamil Nadu

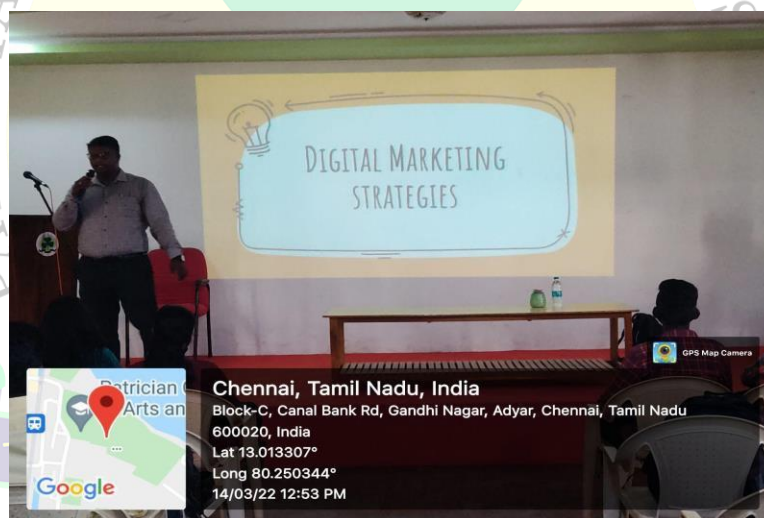
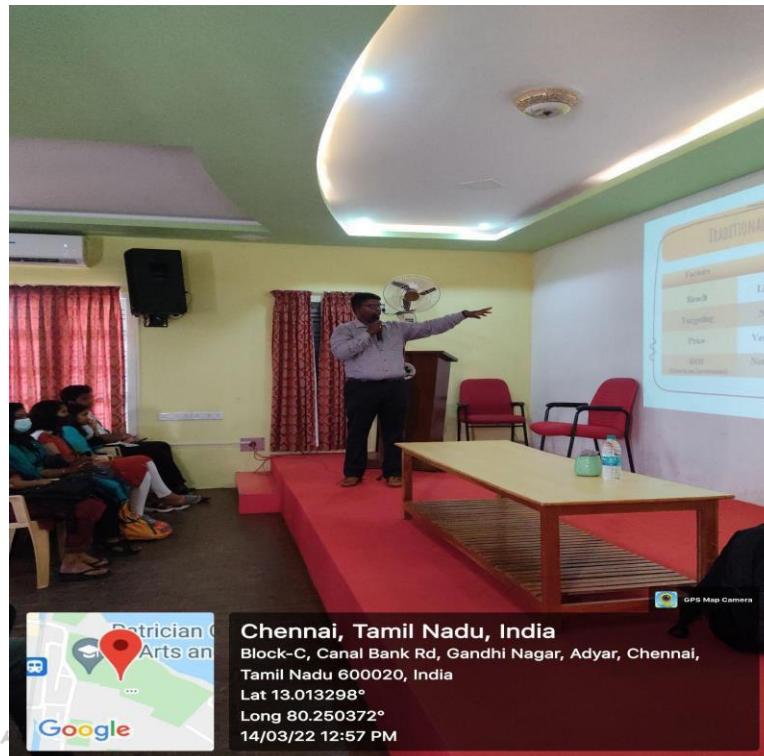
REPORT

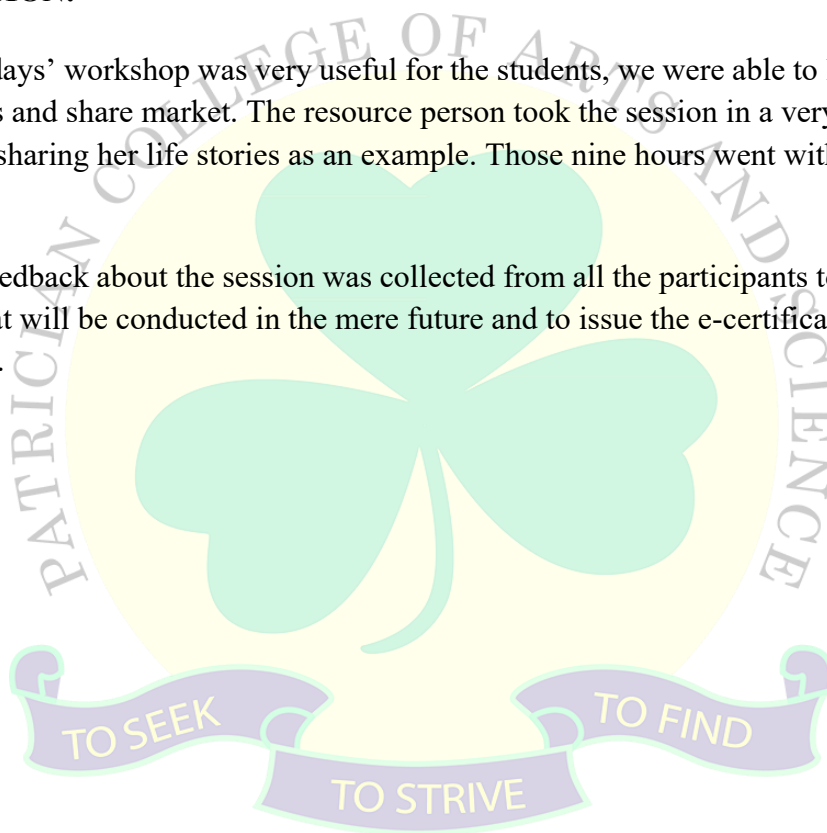




CONCLUSION:

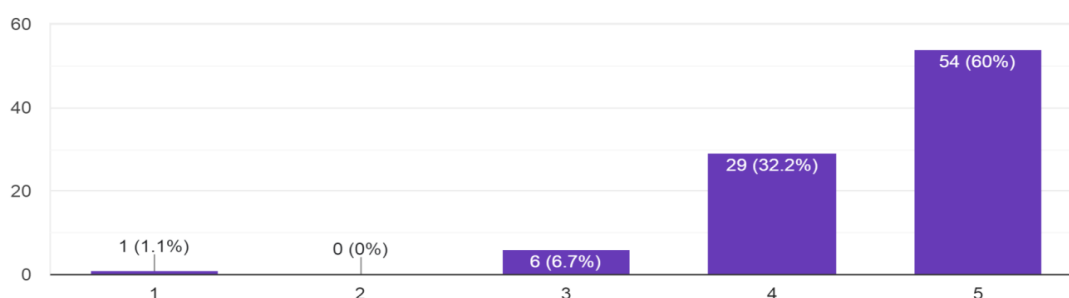

A workshop on “Preparation Tips and Tricks for Higher Education in Mathematics” was organized by Department of Mathematics on 12th April 2022. The day was divided into three sessions. The Resource person for the first session Dr. Ramesh Kasilingam, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics, IIT Madras enlightened the participants with various opportunities for Mathematics students. Also he gave a lecture on the topic “Some results on algebra and vector spaces”.

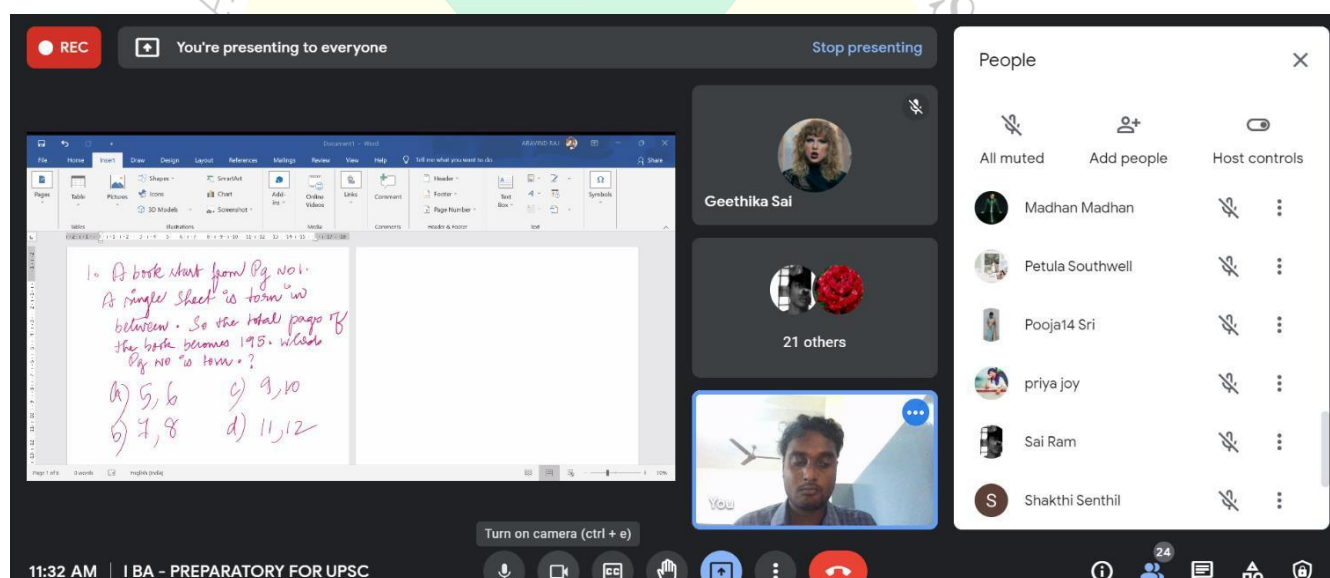
The topics, the wide syllabus, the time required to prepare were part of the presentation. The program ended positively with the students appreciative of the efforts of the department.
