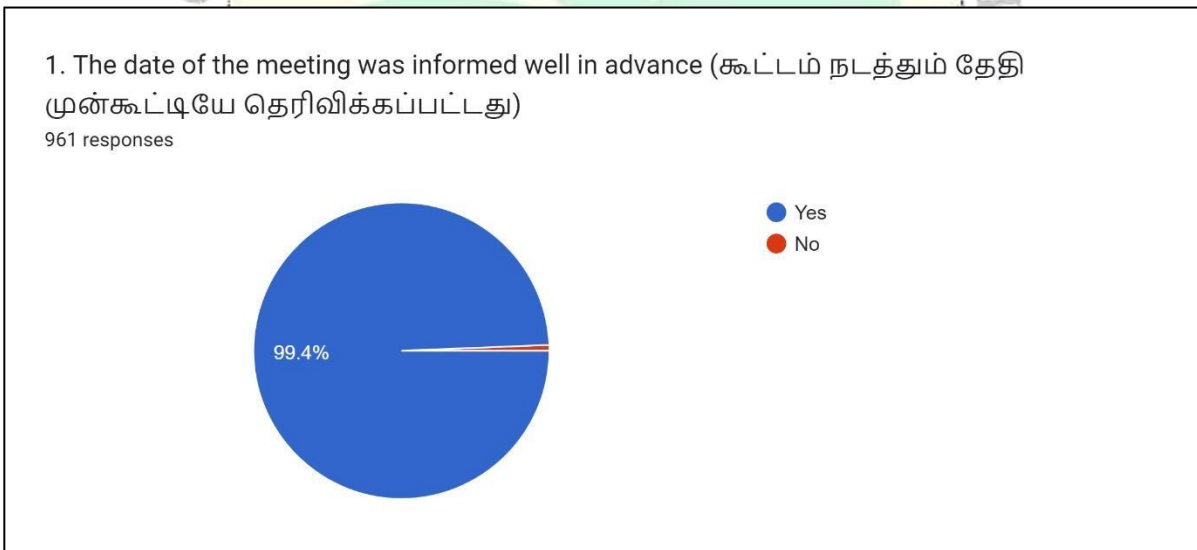

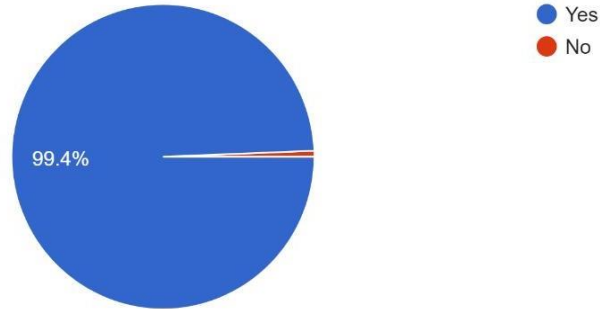

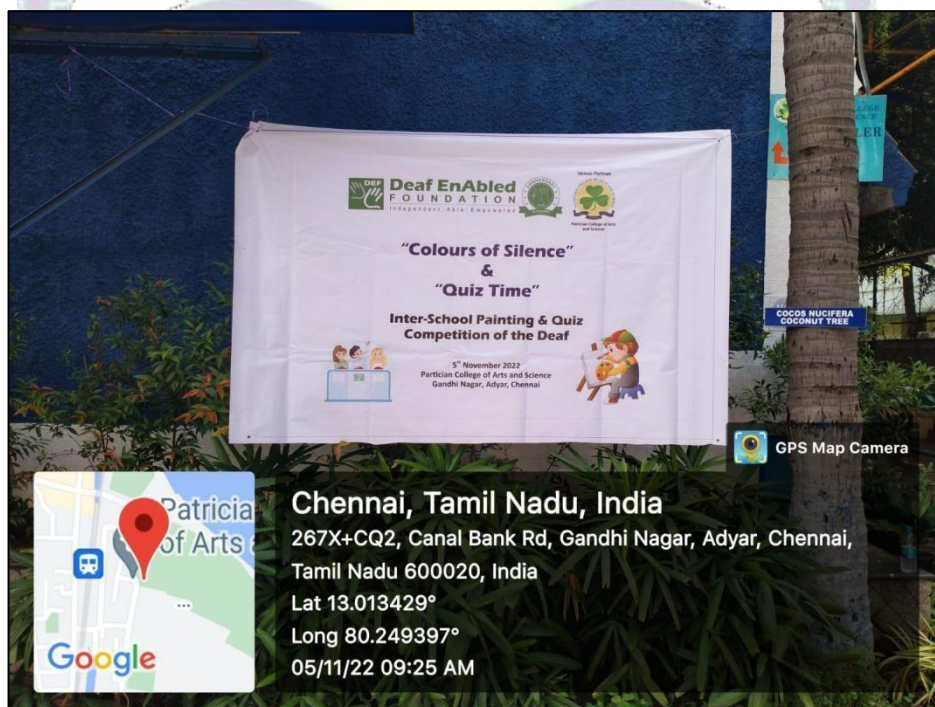
Report of the programme

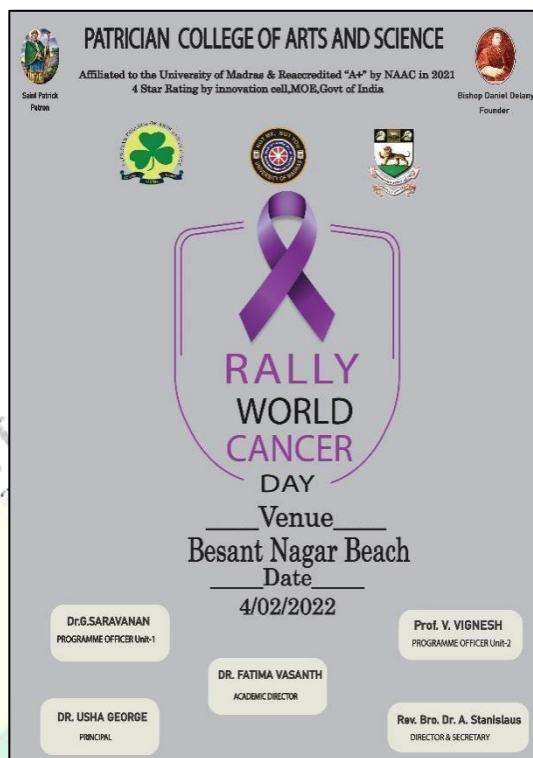
