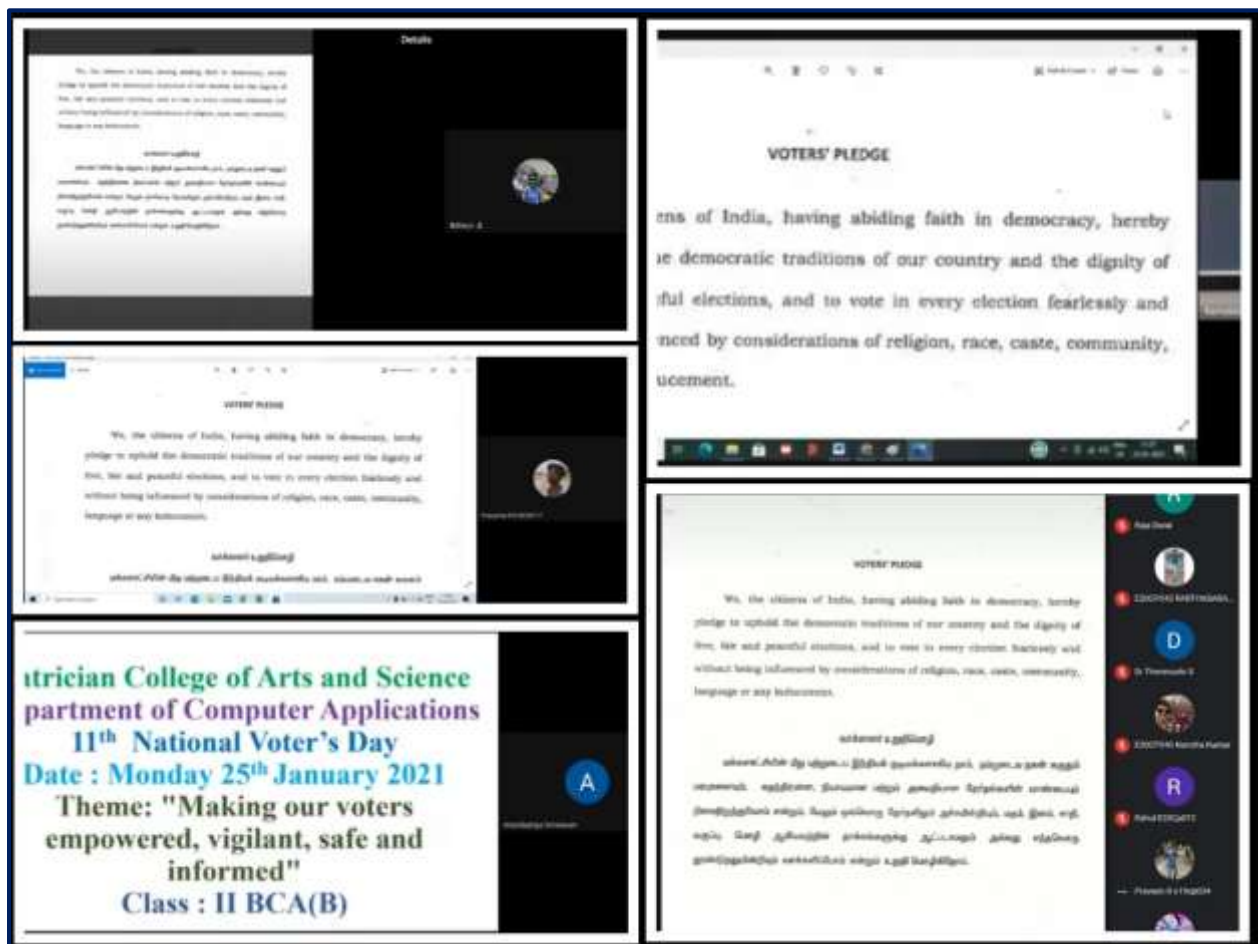


Voter's Day Pledge

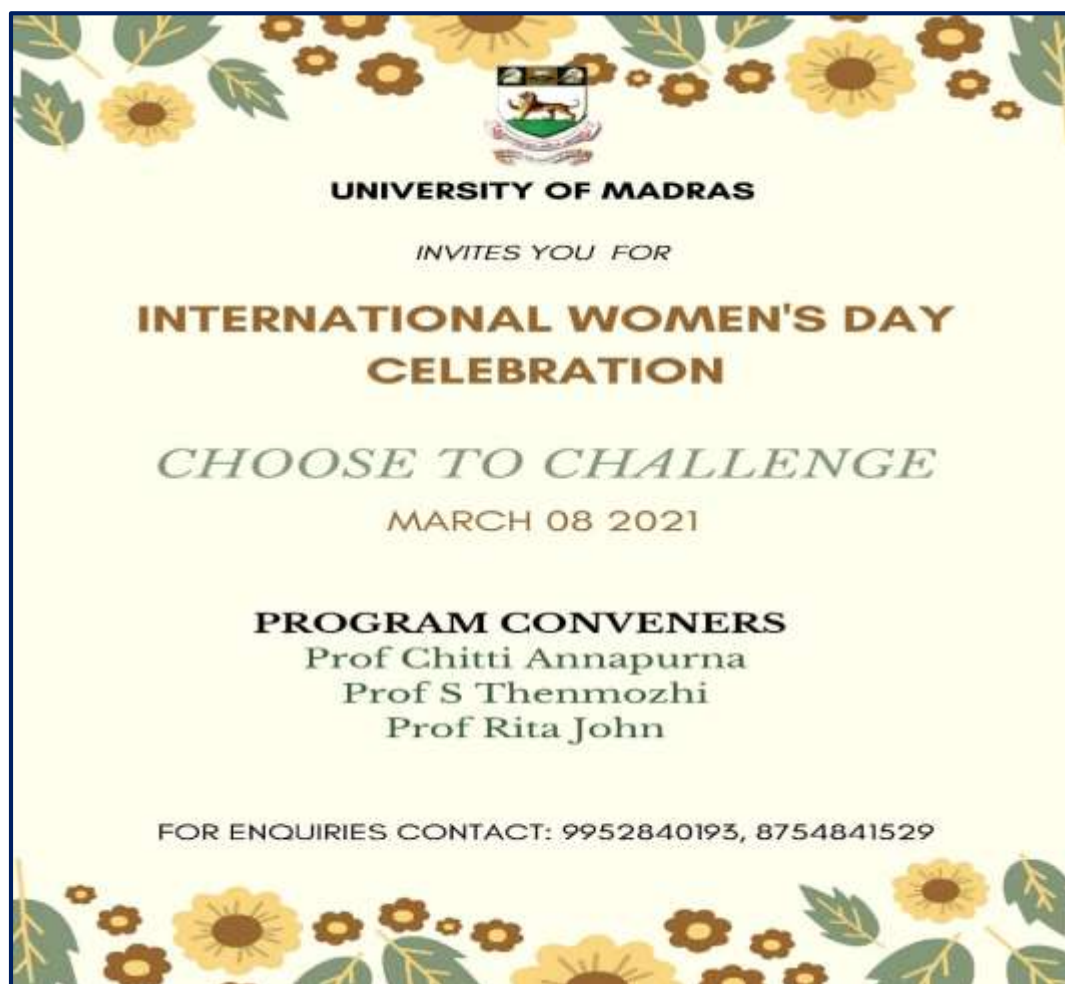

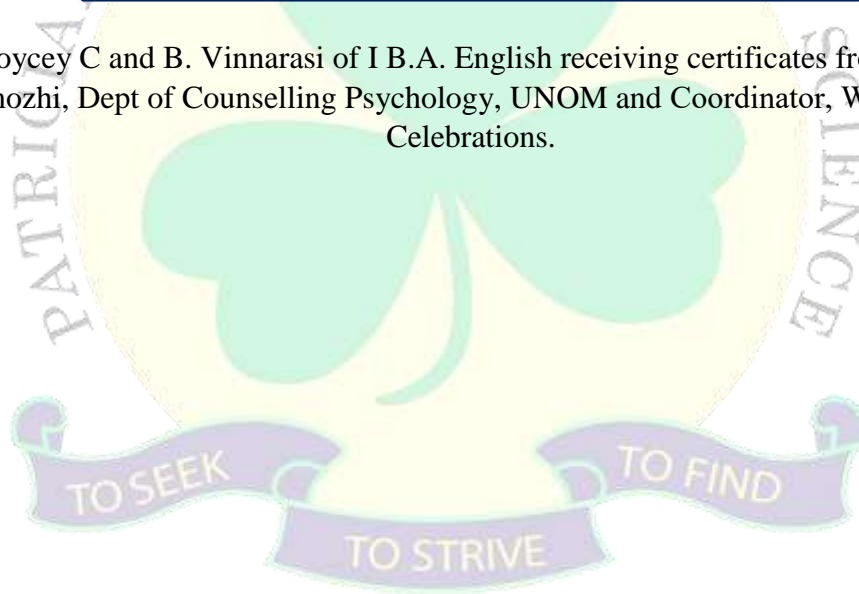

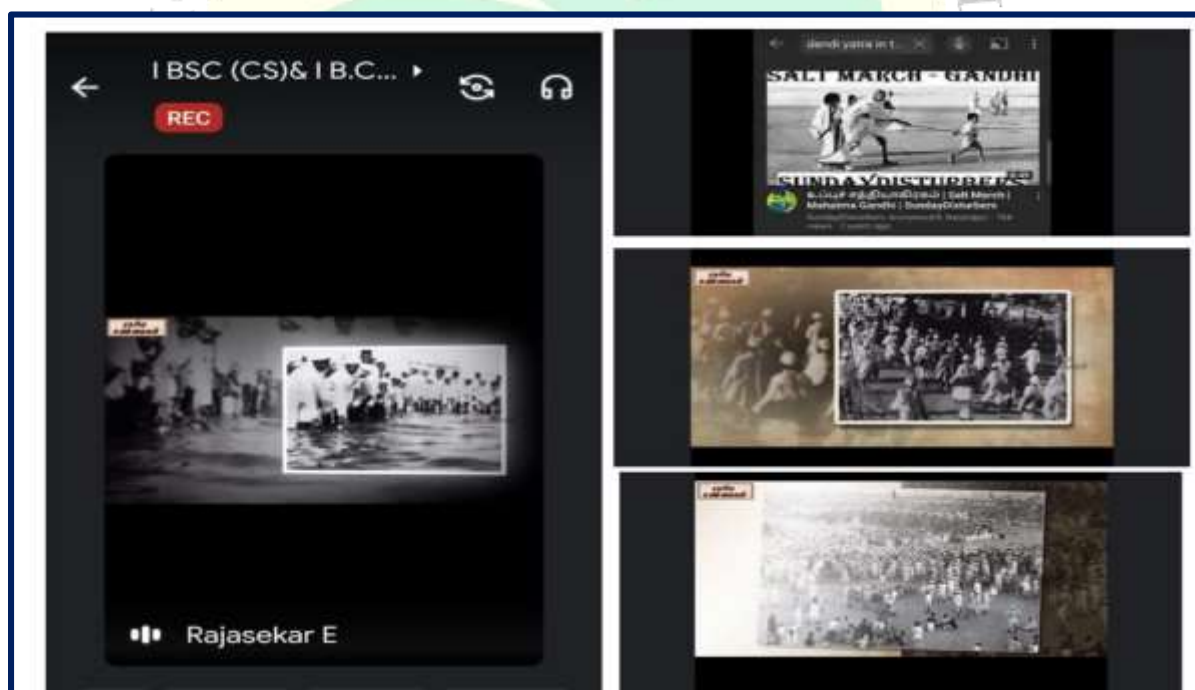


Dandi March of 12th March 1930 – Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav (91st Anniversary Celebrations)

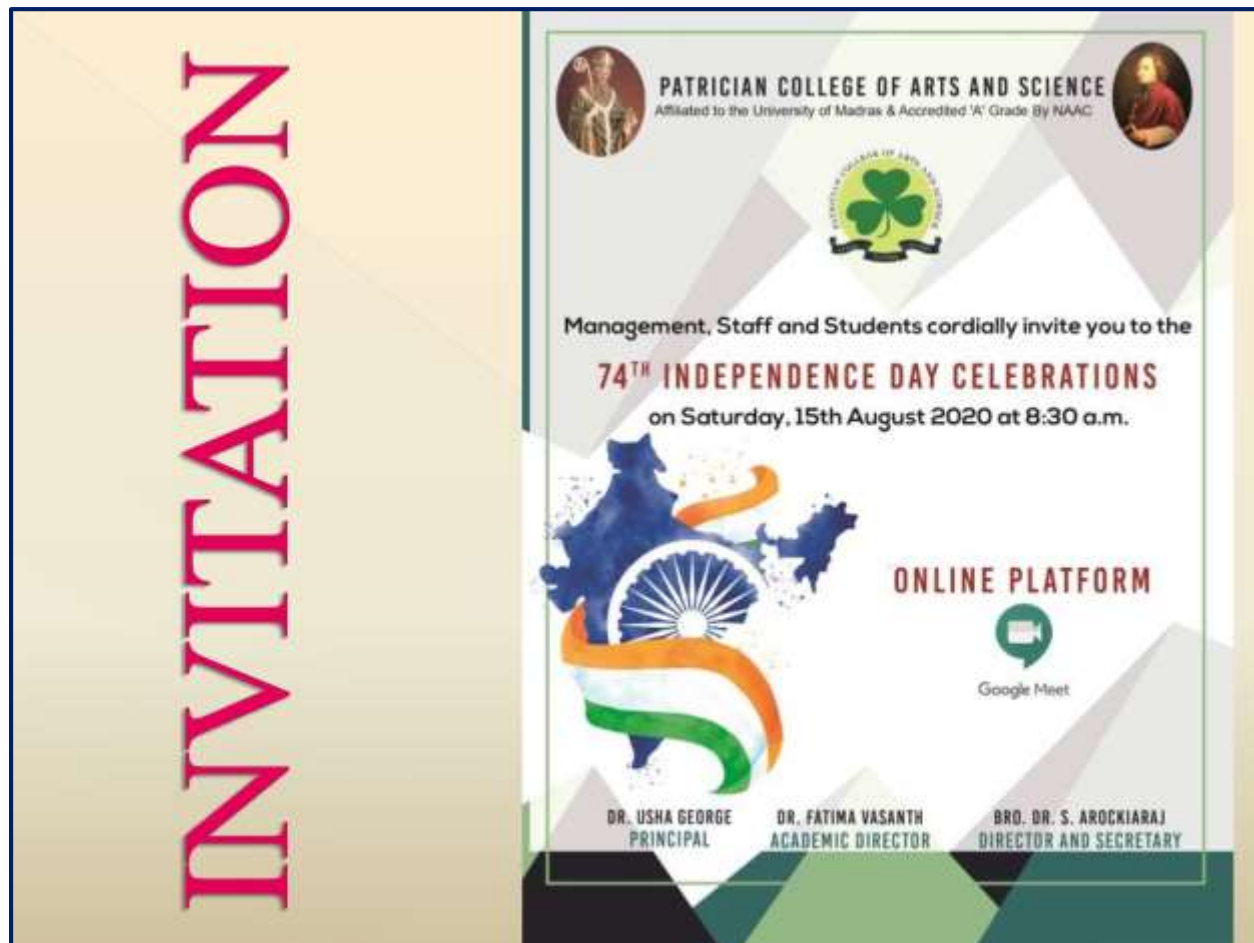
