



Profile of Mr. V. Ponraj

Ponraj Vellaichamy is an ADA Scientist and Technical Advisor to Late His Excellency Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam, the 11th President of India. He has coauthored the book Manifesto for Change along with Dr.Kalam in the year 2014. Honoring the great Indian Scientist, the Former 11th President of India, and the Missile Man Late Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, UNO had declared his birth anniversary, October 15th to be celebrated every year as **World Students' Day** in his remembrance since 2010. 








National Youth Day Celebrations








Voter's Day Pledge








Dandi March of 12th March 1930 – Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav (91st Anniversary Celebrations)
