

Program Summary:

Mr.Ezhilan stated that yoga is a very easy and useful way to keep one's body and mind peaceful and stable. He focused on the importance of meditation and concentration in Yoga and the power of few Asanas.

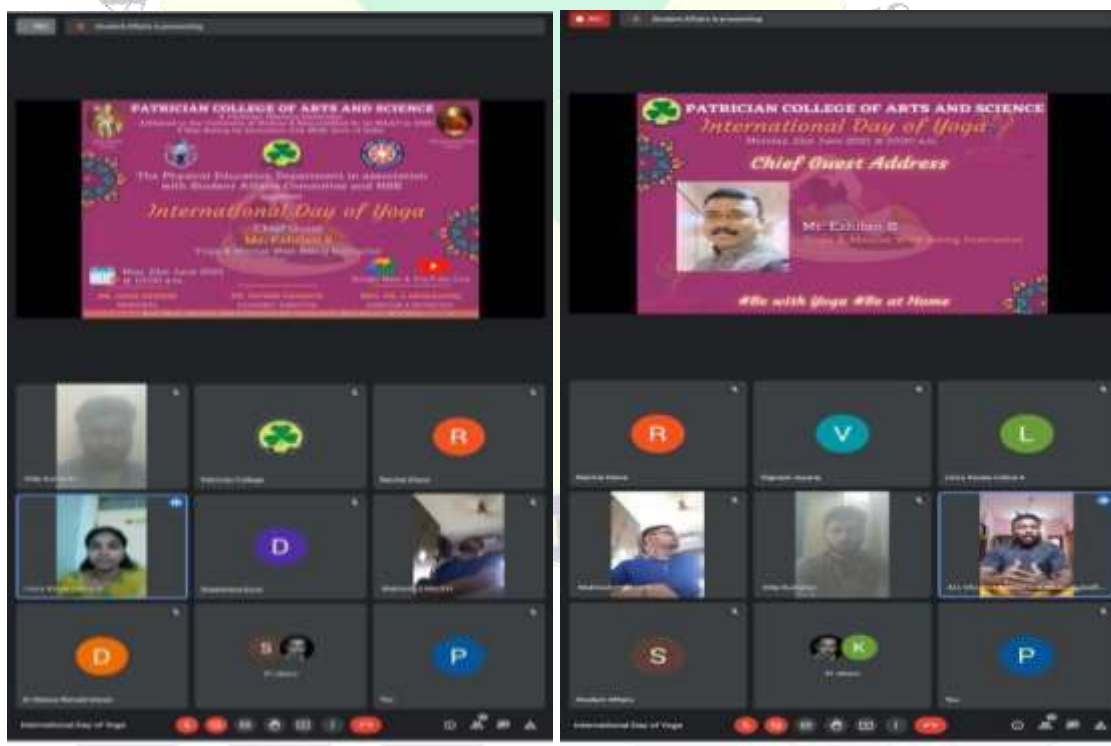

Outcome of the Program:

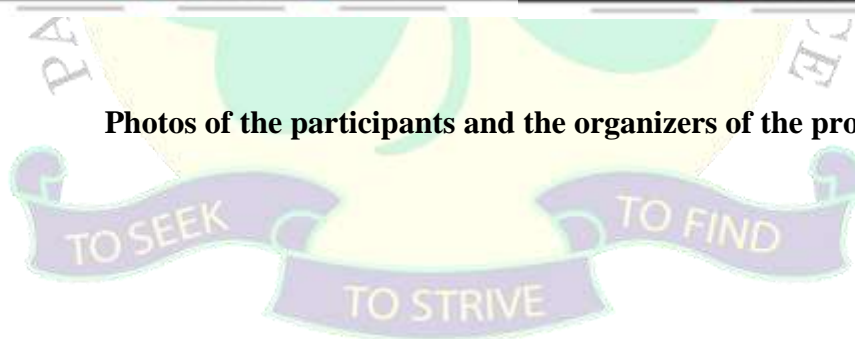
- The students were well educated on the importance of yoga in their lives.

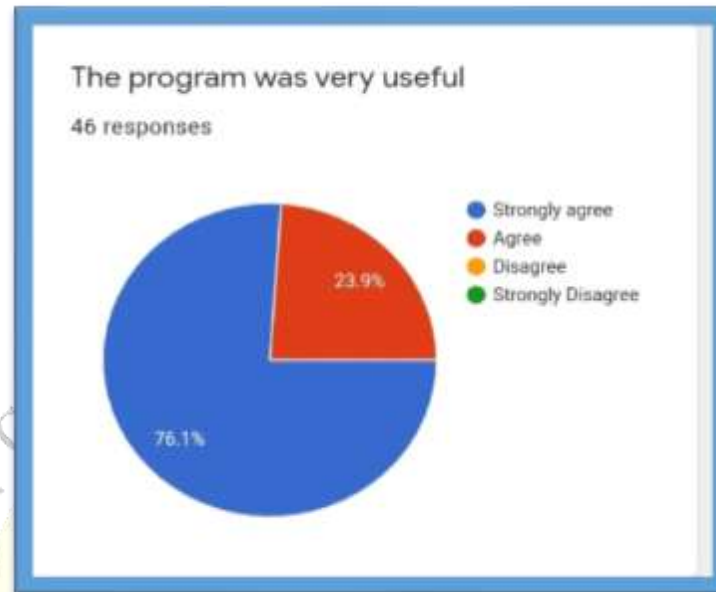
PROGRAM SUMMARY:

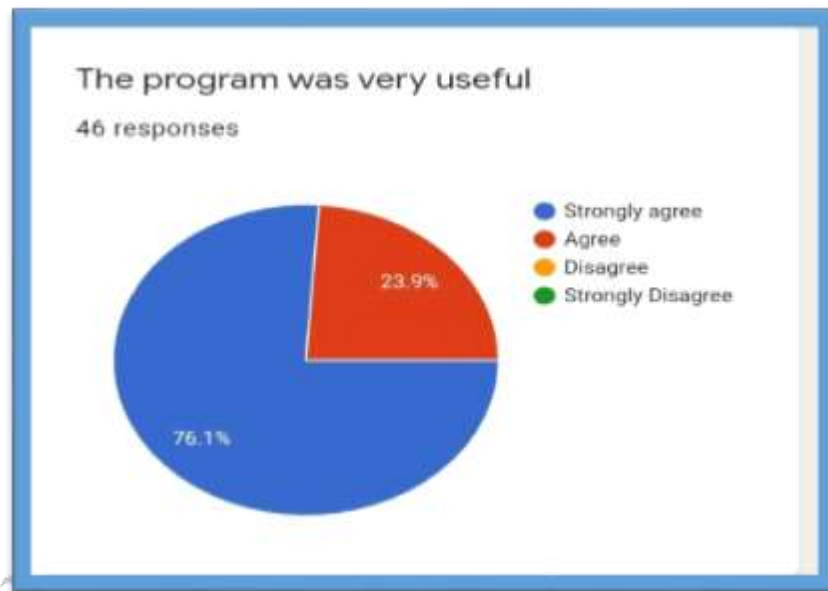

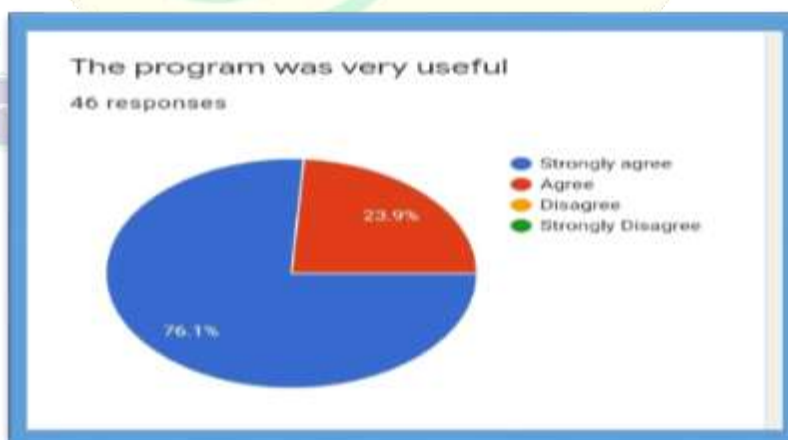
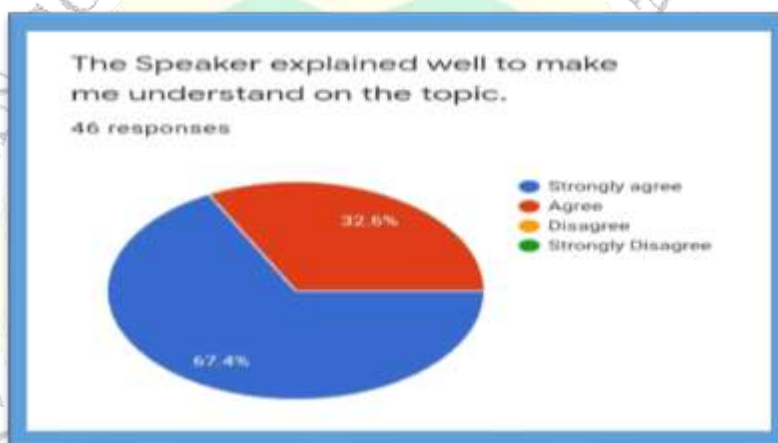
to the negative consequences. The COVID-19 pandemic has made it difficult for the students to adequately maintain their normal physical activities.

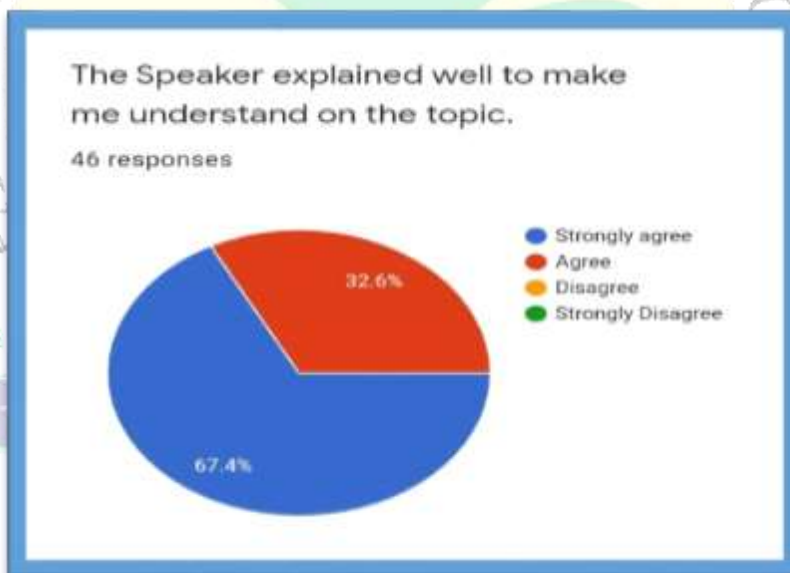

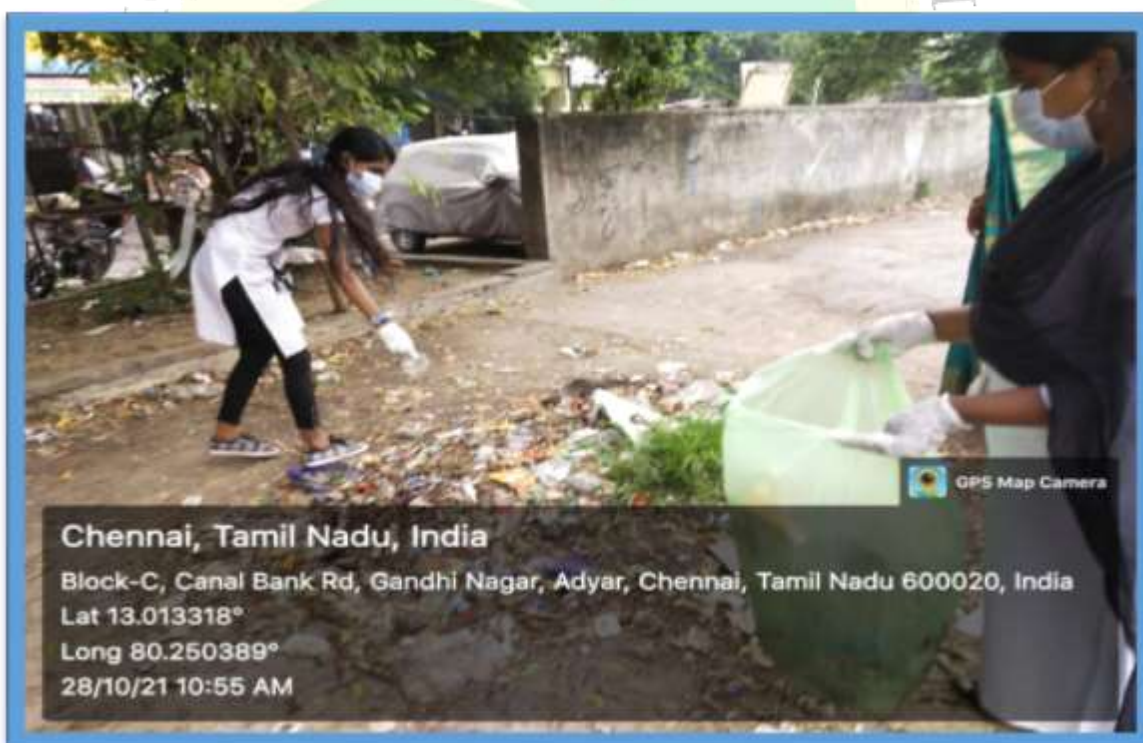
PROGRAM SUMMARY:

The Clean India Campaign took place in Koturpuram Railways Station surroundings near our College. The students have collected plastic and papers.

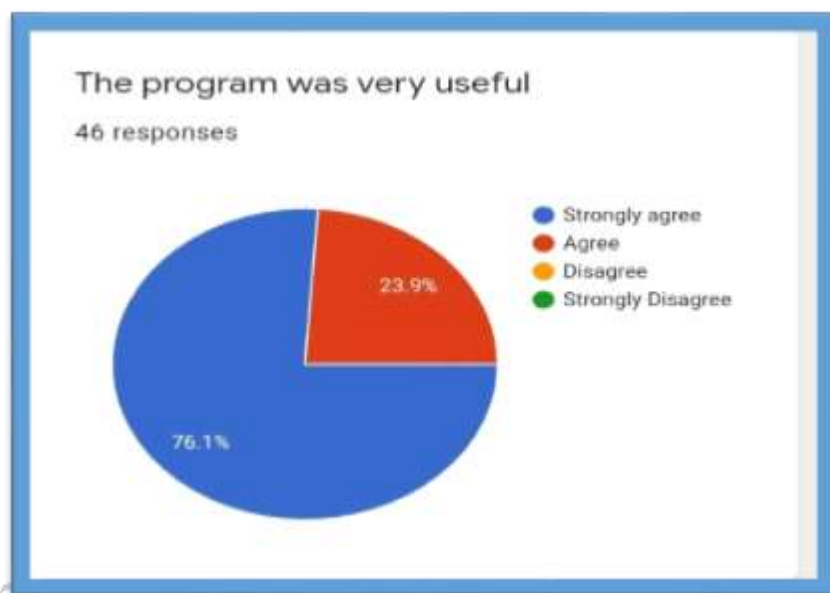

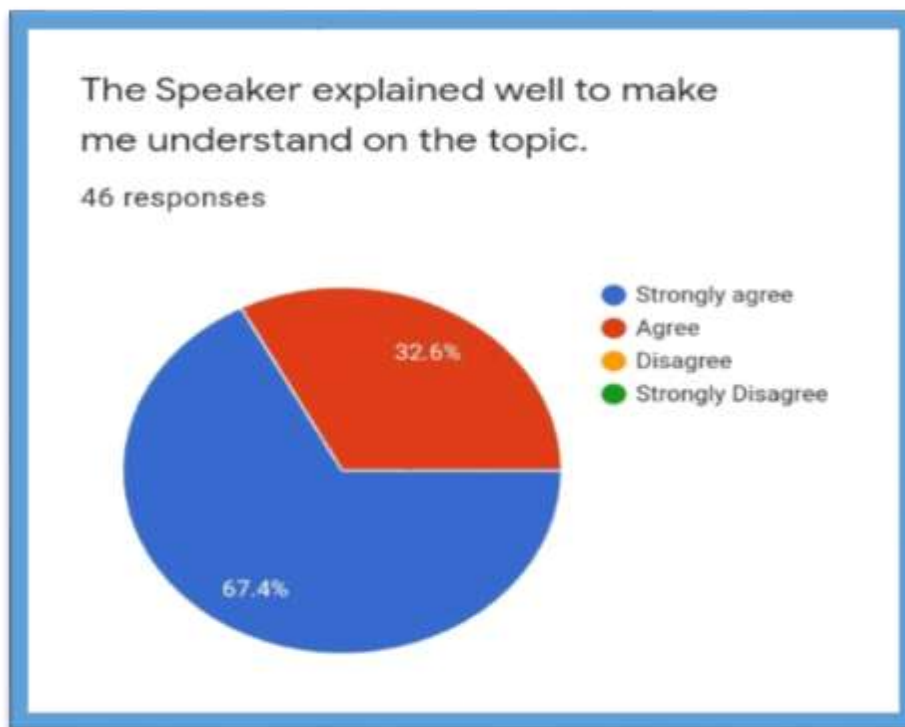
PREAMBLE:

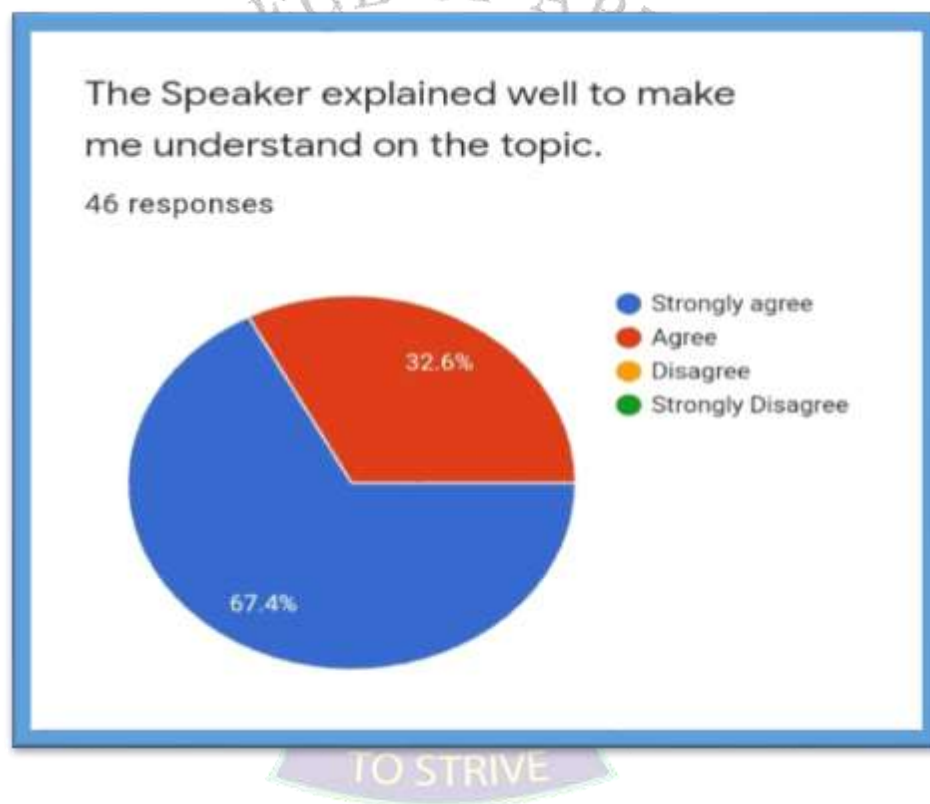
PROGRAM SUMMARY:
