

Program Summary:

The Resource person Mr. Ezhilan briefed about what is yoga and what is the importance of yoga in the life of the youth. He explained various health benefits of the yoga for the youth and also mentioned what are the challenges that the youth face today in terms of societal pressure, media, mobile phones ect. Mr.Ezhilan stated that yoga is a very easy and useful way to keep one's body and mind peaceful and stable. He focused on the importance of meditation and concentration in Yoga and the power of few Asanas.








to the negative consequences. The COVID-19 pandemic has made it difficult for the students to adequately maintain their normal physical activities.









INDEPENDENCE DAY & NSS DAY CELEBRATIONS

The Plant has been adopted by Kishore.V Department of Computer Science.



The Clean India Campaign took place in Koturpuram Railways Station surroundings near our College. The students have collected plastic and papers.


