



Report on Facilities

The College gives special attention to the needs of the differently-able students by providing them with the following resources and facilities:

- Ramps with side bars are available in the B, C, and D Blocks.
- All stairways and ramps are with supporting railings.
- Rest Room in B and D Blocks in the ground floors exclusively reserved for the disabled.
- Wide Corridors and doors to facilitate easy and obstacle free movement towards class rooms and other areas.
- Elevator is available in D block.
- Wheelchair and stretcher provided on demand for injured and physically challenged students.
- Scribes arranged on request as per University regulations and allotted separate rooms during examinations.
- Braille books for access in the library.
- Well maintained sick room and first-aid requirements.

Special Skill Development:

- Competitions are conducted to express their special skills
- They are encouraged to participate in departmental and interdepartmental cultural activities and the programmes organized by the PCEC and ED cell.
- The Paralympics Marathon was held for them during the Cancerathon run coordinated by the NSS Unit.
- To promote their self-esteem and confidence, they were made to inaugurate the new Building at D Block.
- They are given extended library hours, and the parents are permitted entry in the library for parental involvement and counseling is required for their ward during college hours.



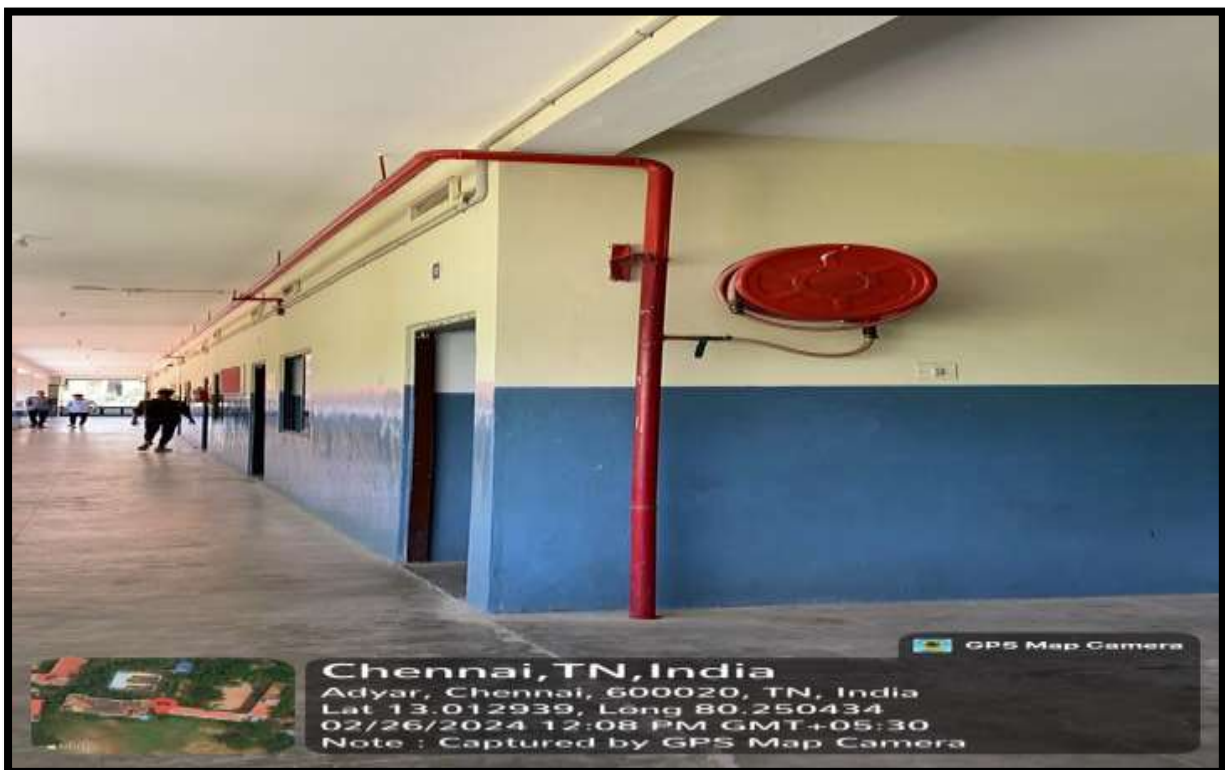

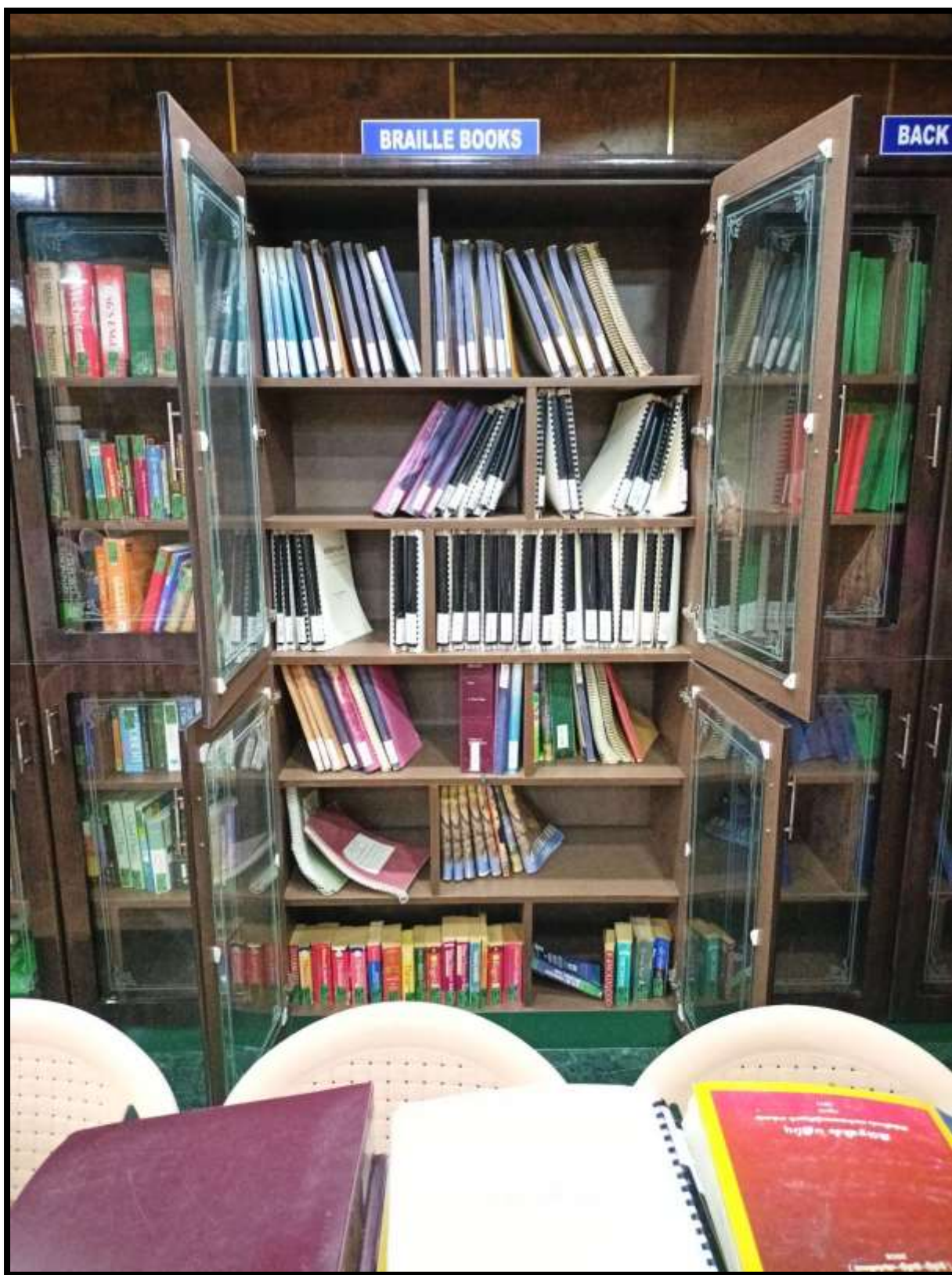
