



FRENCH

In the spirit of the above quote, the French language department prepares its students to broaden their empathy, cultural outlook and mind set to tolerate others' opinion and views and to heighten their employable skills.

L'ESPIRIT, the French cultural club of our college has conducted many competitions in various occasions to provide a platform for the French students to express their linguistic and cultural expertise in French.

On the eve of Independence Day celebrations, an essay writing competition and a poetry writing competition on the topic "l'Inde de nos reves" was conducted and 24 students submitted their essays and three students came up with their poems.

In October the club held various competitions for the current batch of French learning students and all the French students were encouraged to take part at least in one competition. An essay competition with an abstract topic "Elargissez Vos Connaissances "was held, in which 16 students participated. A barrier free Story writing competition was held in which five students participated. All the entries were highly appreciated by both the judges. A poster making competition with the topic "La culture française" was held and 26 participants submitted their posters. A quiz on the glorious French revolution was held online in which 124 responses was recorded. All the participants who scored above 60% were offered E-certificates.

The response from the student community was stupendous and their thought process, linguistic skills, general knowledge, imagination and uniqueness in their communication skills were amazing. The participants on their side were content to discover their talents and abilities.

Apart from that the club also organised two guest lectures by eminent and experienced DELF Examination trainer Ms.AbiramiSantosh, on the topics. Comment rediger un essaiefficase?" and "Les expressions hypothetiquesfrançaises' ' for first year and second year students respectively.




