



# PATRICIAN SEEDS CARE AND SHARE PROGRAM

#### **Christmas Celebration with Irular Community – December 2021**

Patrician Seeds in association with SEEDs committees of Department of Management and Department of Commerce (G) (Shift I) organized an outreach programme, CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION WITH IRULAR COMMUNITY under the Guidance of Brother Dr.S. Arockiaraj Director and Secretary, Dr.Fatima Vasanth Academic Director, Dr.Usha George Principal, Dr.Geetha Rufus Vice Principal Shift 2 and Dr.Meena Vice-Principal Shift 1. Purpose of this Christmas celebration is to give relief materials to the Irular community residing at Saidapet, Chennai affected by heavy rains. Before the Christmas celebration, Patrician SEEDS coordinator, Dr. A. Raja, visited the Irular tribe on 07/12/2021 to do the field visit. As the result of the survey, he found that how pathetic Irular tribes are living in wretched condition without having proper shelter, food and drinking water. Somehow, the tribes were managed to prepare their shelters with rugged sacks and flex banners. Thereby, they were living under thatched roofs. Patrician college management in association with Patrician Seeds team extended its helping hands to the tribal people during Christmas season. The conditions and the details of Irular tribes from the location as follows:

- Totally, twenty-five Irular tribe members are living in the mentioned area.
- Patrician Seeds BBA donated 15 groceries bags total worth of Rs. 8000/-


#### **Christmas Celebrations and Care and Share:**




# PATRICIAN COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE STAFF CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION 2021
