
**Event: Care and Share Program** 

Date: 13/01/2023



On Day 4 students learned how to make phenol and vessel cleaning gel. In phenol making the substance for making phenol was added in water and mixed well by the mentor and students. After they mixed it well they added dye for color. They have prepared 3 colors. After phenol making, mentor taught how to make vessel cleaning gel.
