Transect Walk:

Objective of the Transect Walk:

To select the population and Identify, observe the problems in the population.

- First Transect Walk in Alandur Village: Ponnamman Kovil street, Alandur

Date: 26-09-2022 Monday

As a part of the transect walk two faculty members and two III year students from the Department of Commerce (Shift 1) went for a transect walk inside the village and met the local people. Visited Alandur Panchayat office, market, playground, water tank, police station.

We got the details of the Panchayat head and the meeting with the Panchayat head will be scheduled in the coming weeks.

- Second Transect Walk in Alandur Village: Lal Street, Alandur

Date: 30-09-2022 , Friday

Second transect Walk held on 30th September 2022. Mrs. Vaidehi Assistant professor and Dr. Meera Assistant professor along with seven students visited Jal street. Met principal and school teachers in Chennai High school , Lal Street. Get Permission from Principal for conducting programmes.

Observation in th Chennai High school:

There was no proper facilities in that school like toilet facility, water , proper building, tables and chairs. They require additional tents as there are 250 students in the school.

No proper benches were available for all the students, so many were sitting on the floor. They require mats for those students

Observation in Alandur village Panchayat during transect walk

- There is no proper water facility, street light, road facility in that area.
- So many students and all the local people travel 5 to 6 km which takes 30 min. There is no sufficient local transport facility
- There is a poor drainage system in that area
- People doesn't know the awareness of Health and Hygienic.

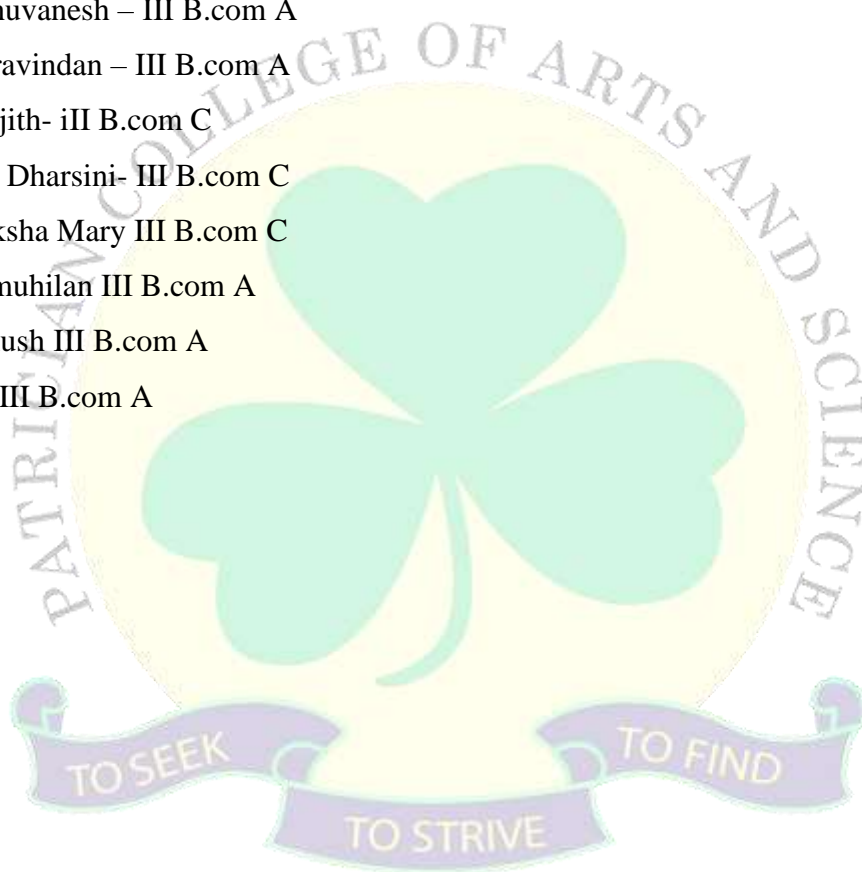

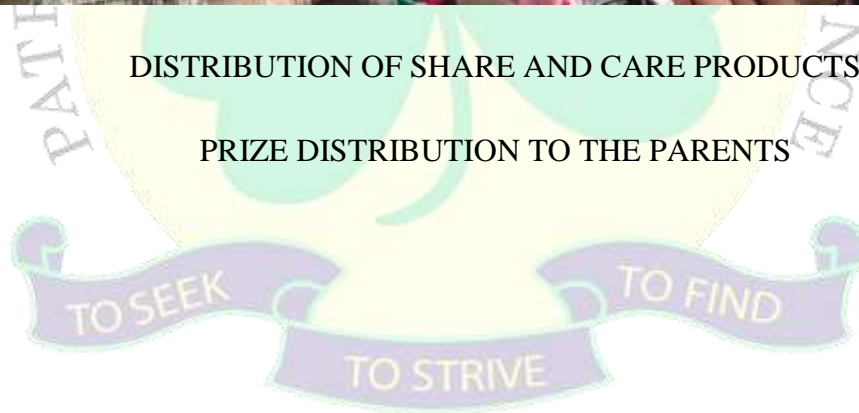

No proper benches were available for all the students, so many were sitting on the floor. They require mats for those students

Observation in Navallur village Panchayat during transect walk

- There is no connecting Bridge from Uthandi, ECR, and Navallur.
- So many students and all the local people travel 12 km which takes 40 min.
- There is a proposal to construct a bridge so that they can travel in 10 minutes

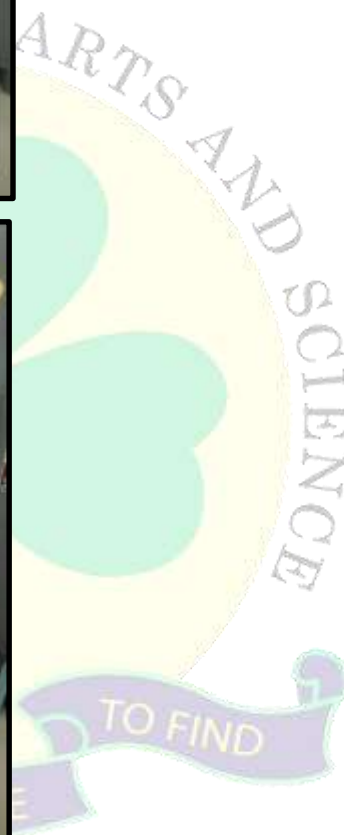
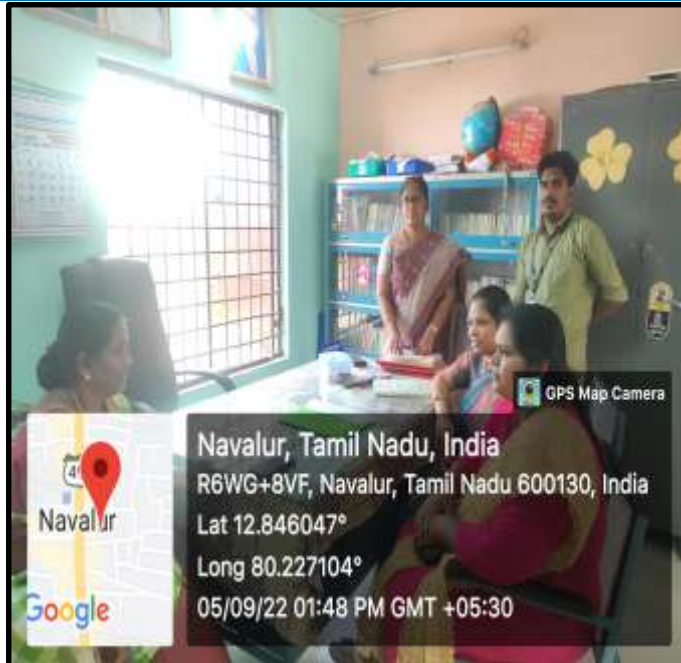

Then we met the Principal and Vice Principal Mrs. Mary Shanthani and discussed about the needs of the student community in the village.

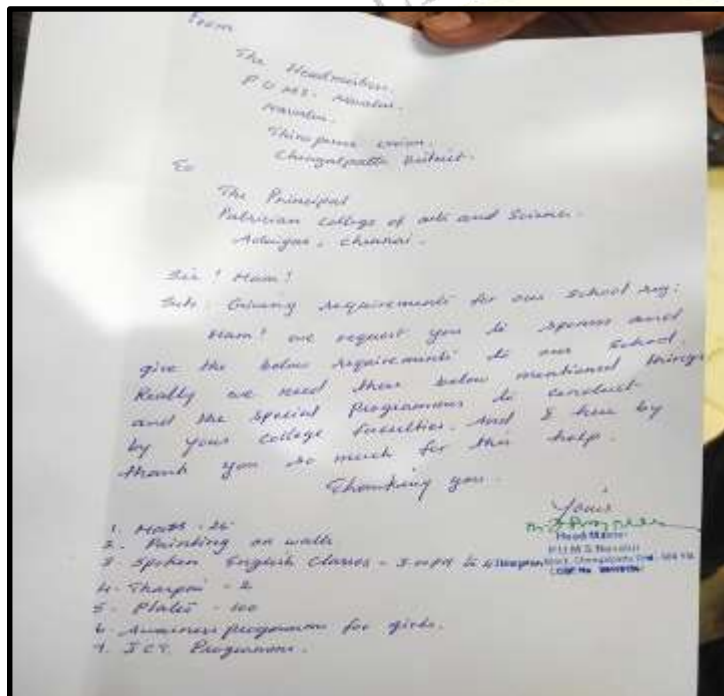

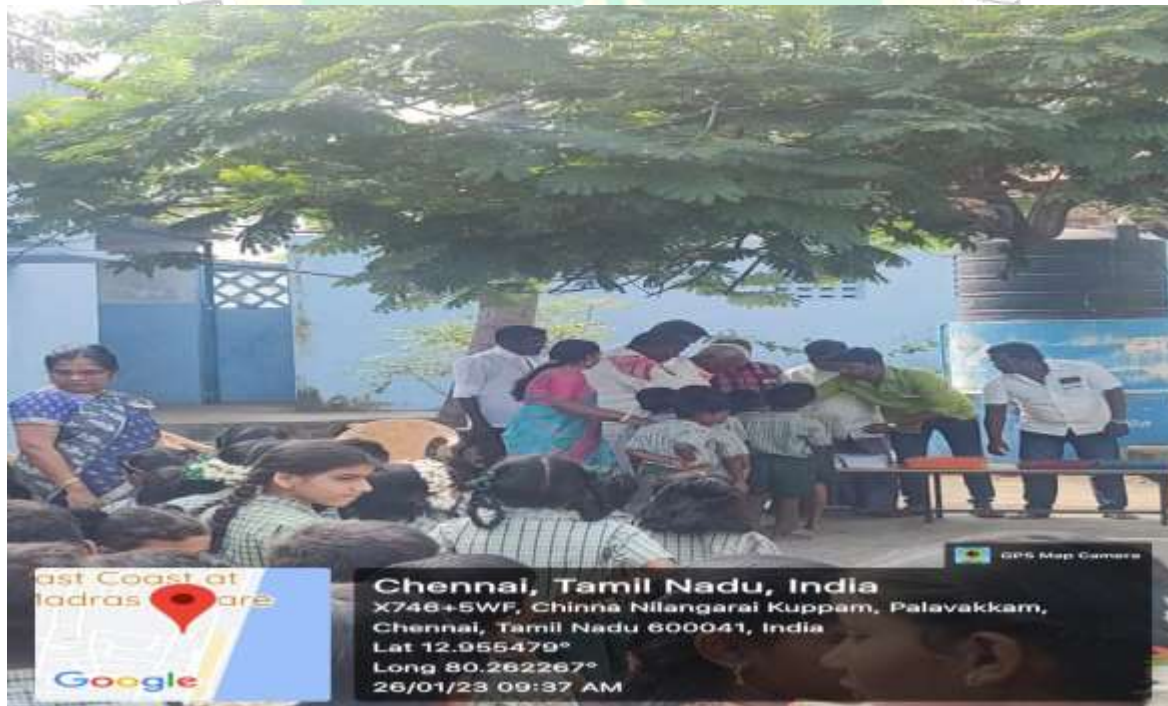

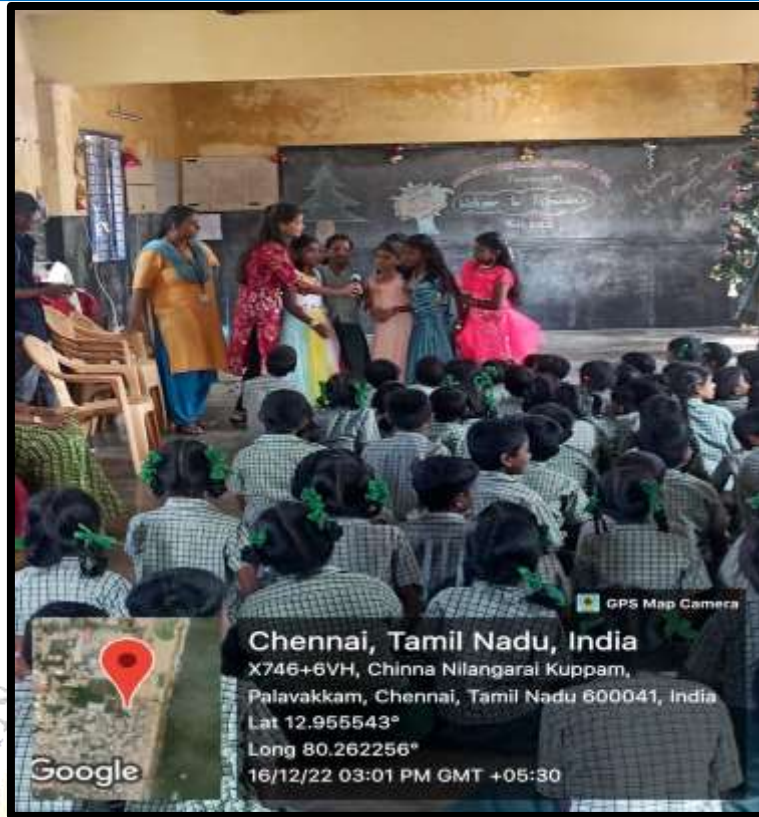

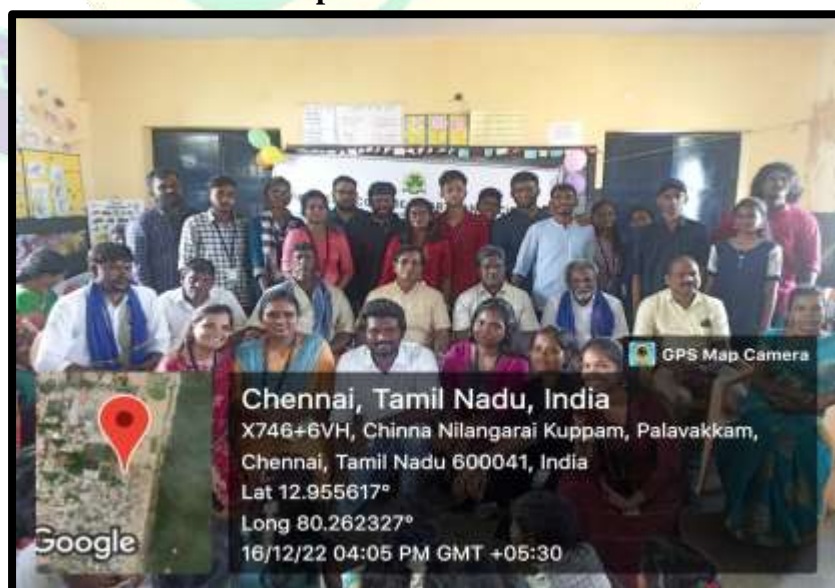
