- Dr S S Sundaram, asked reasons for Faculty participation in the MOOC Courses in less and zero enrollment for the programme MSc Mathematics
- Academic Director Dr Fatima Vasanth replied, only few enquiries and candidates have the feeling of this programme is not economically viable

 polularize the Mathematics subject to get enrollments in the future admissions and
 told even in MCC were not able to fill the seats in BSc Mathematics -Shift II and MSc
 Maths were able to fill.
- Dr S S Sundaram has also mentioned that in many colleges have not filled seats in UG
 & PG Mathematics
- Dr. J. Madhavan, suggested, Multiple representation per faculty so numbers to be reconciled, like induction programmed for New Faculty, and programmes for Newly admitted students and Principal replied that We do have programme for I UG & I PG students., suggested to give Awards to faculty for their research publications.
